Schedule

Development partly or wholly within land to which State Environmental Planning Policy No 71 – Coastal Protection applies, and to which State Environmental Planning Policy No 1 – Development Standards, State Environmental Planning Policy No 14 – Coastal Wetlands or State Environmental Planning Policy No 26 – Littoral Rainforests apply, which requires the concurrence of the Minister or The Director-General, and which except for clause 9(2)(a) of State Environmental Planning Policy No 71, would otherwise be State significant development pursuant to clause 10(1) of that Policy.
