## **FISHERIES MANAGEMENT ACT 1994**

Section 8 Notification – Fishing Closure

Lake Wetherall, Lake Tandure, Lake Bijijie, Lake Balaka and Lake Malta

Counties of Livingstone and Tandora

I, Richard Sheldrake, prohibit the taking of crustaceans (including yabbies and molluscs) by the methods of fishing as described in Column 1 of the Schedule to this notification, from the waters specified in Column 2 of that schedule, for the period specified.

This prohibition will be effective for a period of 60 days from the date of publication of this notification, unless sooner varied or revoked by notification of the Deputy Director-General, Agriculture and Fisheries.

Note: The word 'Regulation', where appearing in this notification, refers to the Fisheries Management (General) Regulation 2002.
