SPECIAL SUPPLEMENT

LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1993 – PROCLAMATION

MARIE BASHIR, Governor
I, Professor MARIE BASHIR AC, Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of sections 256 and 736 of the Local Government Act 1993, do, by this Proclamation, declare that the Proclamation published in the Special Supplement of the Government Gazette No 56 of 16 March 2004, declaring all civic offices in relation to Liverpool City Council to be vacant and appointing an Administrator of Liverpool City Council, is amended as follows:

Omit clause (c) of the Proclamation and insert instead:

- (c) order that the term of the Administrator will commence immediately and cease on the date of the Council's next ordinary elections to be held on 22 September 2008; and
- (d) appoint the Director General of the Department of Local Government as substitute Administrator for the term described in clause (c) being for the limited purpose of determining any matter before the Liverpool City Council that the Administrator is unable or unavailable to determine for such reasons that may include, but are not limited to, the declaration of a pecuniary interest, the declaration of a conflict of interest, illness, or other absence.
