EXHIBITION OF THE DRAFT HILLSTON RURAL FLOODPLAIN MANAGEMENT PLAN (LAKE BREWSTER TO WHEALBAH)

Invitation for Public Submissions

THE Minister for Natural Resources hereby notifies the exhibition of the draft Hillston Rural Floodplain Management Plan.

The draft plan was prepared by the Department of Infrastructure, Planning and Natural Resources (DIPNR) (on behalf of the Water Administration Ministerial Corporation) in conjunction with the Hillston Rural Floodplain Management Committee. It was prepared in accordance with the provisions of Part 8 of the Water Act 1912. This is a Natural Heritage Trust (NHT) and NSW Government funding project.

The draft plan aims to coordinate existing and future development on the floodplain so that flood risk to the community is minimised and the natural functions of the floodplain environment are sustained. It specifies modifications to existing works based on hydraulic and environmental criteria and identifies a floodway network for the planning of proposed works.

When is the Plan being exhibited?

The Plan will be publicly exhibited for a period of 46 days. The exhibition period is planned to start on 1 February 2005 and end on 18 March 2005.

Where can I view the Plan?

The draft plan is available for public inspection weekdays during normal office hours at the following location:

What area does the draft Plan apply to?

As shown, the plan area extends along the Lachlan floodplain from above Lake Brewster to about 10 kilometres downstream of Whealbah Bridge. To the west, the plan area extends to the Whealbah - Trida Road and includes the floodplains of Willandra, Middle and Merrowie Creeks and their associated flood runners.

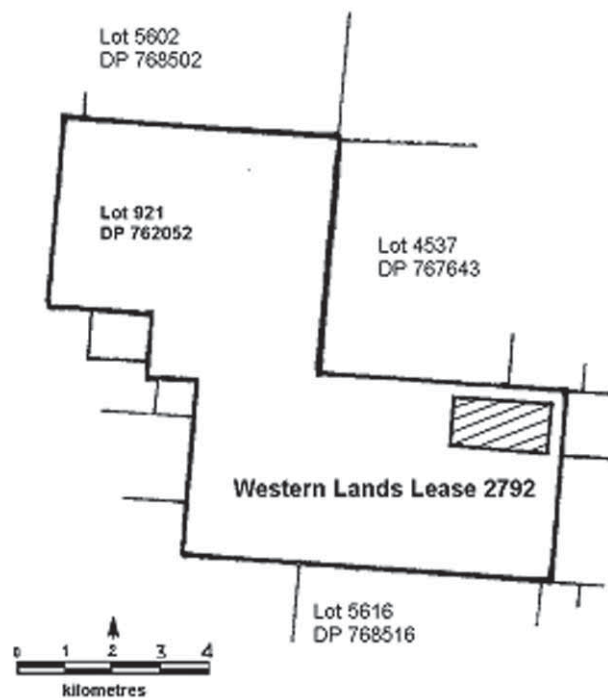

“Guidelines for Managing School Students’ Behaviour on Buses”

ADDENDUM

THE Ministry of Transport is implementing a Tcard system for students in the Greater Sydney Metropolitan Area who use private buses under the School Student Transport Scheme. To be eligible for free travel, students must present their student travel pass and Tcard on boarding a bus.

The purpose of the Tcard system is to collect actual travel usage data, and when the system is fully developed, Tcards may carry cash value in the “Tpurse” or other concession fare products that are owned by the cardholder. For these reasons, it would rarely be appropriate for an operator or a driver to retain or confiscate a Tcard.

Where a student fails to present a student travel pass and/or Tcard upon boarding a bus, an Interim Travel Notice may be issued which is valid for one or 14 days, depending on the circumstances.

When implementing procedures for dealing with incidents of students’ misbehaviour on buses, drivers/operators should be aware that under no circumstances should a student be asked to relinquish his/her Tcard.

Guidelines for dealing with confiscation of student travel passes for any breach of the code of conduct are as follow:

A Where students use bus services provided by the same operator

Students in possession of	Document to be taken away by drivers/operators due to breach of code of conduct	Subsequent action to be taken by drivers/operators
Student travel pass + Tcard	Only student travel pass	Issue interim pass, if applicable
Interim Travel Notice + Tcard	Only Interim Travel Notice	Issue interim pass, if applicable
Student travel pass + Interim Travel Notice	Only student travel pass	Issue interim pass, if applicable
Interim Travel Notice	None	Issue interim pass, if applicable. Note on Interim Travel Notice about validity period of interim pass.

B Where students use more than one operator’s bus services, the same procedures in (A) will apply, but bus drivers/operators should only collect the Interim Travel Notice which they have issued to replace a student travel pass.
