FISHERIES MANAGEMENT ACT 1994 s.8 Notification - Fishing Closure

<u>Line Fishing</u> <u>Stockton Beach (Stockton) to Big Gibber (Hawks Nest)</u>

I, IAN MACDONALD MLC, Minister for Primary Industries, pursuant to section 8 of the *Fisheries Management Act 1994* ("the Act"), do by this notification, prohibit the taking of all species of fish by the methods of fishing specified in Column 1 of the Schedule of this notification, from waters shown in Column 2 of the Schedule.

This prohibition is effective until the 31st December 2005.

c. A single bait or combination of baits exceeding 200 grams in total.	

Explanatory Note: The object of this fishing closure is to reduce the risk of harming Great White Sharks by line fishing.
