Section 8 Notification - Fishing Closure

F

Black Road Bait Ground

(ocean waters adjacent to North Narrabeen Beach)

I, Richard Sheldrake, prohibit the taking of fish by use of purse seine net from waters known as the Black Road Bait Ground, and from all ocean waters contained within the following boundaries.

Boundaries (closed waters):

Commencing at the eastern extremity of North Narrabeen Head, a line drawn east for a distance of approximately 1650 metres to the 30 fathom depth contour; then southerly along the 30 fathom depth contour to a point approximately 2650 metres due east of South Narrabeen Surf Life Saving Club, then by a line drawn west to that Club.

The closure will be effective for a period of five (5) years from the date of publication of this notification.

Section 8 Notification – Fishing Closure

Caulerpa

I, Dr Richard Sheldrake, prohibit the taking of fish by the methods of fishing specified in Column 1 of Schedules 1 to 6 of this notification, from the waters shown opposite in Column 2, respectively of those Schedules.

This closure is effective for a period of two (2) years from the date of publication unless sooner revoked.

All references to the Regulation in this notice relate to the Fisheries Management (General) Regulation 2002.

All references to a map prepared by the Deputy Director General, Agriculture and Fisheries in this notice relate to a map prepared from time to time and notified to local angling clubs and affected commercial fishers, and displayed at the nearest office of NSW Department of Primary Industries (Fisheries), on the NSW DPI website at www.fisheries.nsw.gov.au, and displayed at the nearest local council office.
