

HERITAGE ACT 1977

INTERIM HERITAGE ORDER NO. 104

Japanese Midget Submarine (M24) wreck site

Unincorporated Waters, Northern Beaches, Sydney

IN pursuance of Section 24 of the Heritage Act, 1977, I, the Minister for Planning, do, by this my order:

- (i) make an interim heritage order in respect of the item of the environmental heritage specified or described in Schedule 'A'; and
- (ii) declare that the interim heritage order shall apply to the curtilage or site of such item, being the land described in Schedule 'B'.

SCHEDULE "A"

The item known as the Japanese Midget Submarine M24 Historic Shipwreck, situated in waters within the limit of the State (Unincorporated Waters), adjacent to the Northern Beaches of Sydney on and in the land described in Schedule "B".

SCHEDULE "B"

All those elements of the item and associated relics in or on the land, located underwater, encapsulated within a radius of 500 metres from a centroid catalogued at HC plan 2207 in the office of the Heritage Council of New South Wales, being in unincorporated waters within the limits of NSW State Waters.
