EXOTIC DISEASES OF ANIMALS ACT 1991

Equine influenza

General Permit to move specified animal products, fodder, fittings and vehicles out of, into or within a Restricted Area (Red) (section 24)

To all persons in New South Wales,

Pursuant to section 24 of the Exotic Diseases of Animals Act 1991 ("the Act") I hereby:

- 1. revoke the permit entitled "Permit to move specified animal products, fodder, fittings and vehicles out of, into or within a restricted area" dated 21 September 2007, and any permit revived as a result of this revocation.
- 2. permit
 - (a) the things specified in Schedule 1, subject to the conditions specified in Schedule 1; and
 - (b) the things specified in Schedule 2, subject to the conditions specified in Schedule 2

to be moved out of, into or within any Restricted Area (Red)

SCHEDULE 1

Specified Things

All animal products from horses that are:

- (a) chilled or frozen semen or embryos from horses,
- (b) blood, urine or other diagnostic samples from horses that are:
 - (i) taken directly to a diagnostic laboratory, and
 - (ii) either held or disposed of in a manner approved under Australian Standards for the secure disposal of biological waste,

SCHEDULE 2

Specified Things

- 1. All fodder that has not been in; and
- 2. All vehicles and fittings that have been cleaned and disinfected after contact with, or use in connection with, any horse or any animal products from horses except those animal products from horses specified in Schedule 1

Definitions

In this Permit:

contact means touching or coming within twenty metres of any horse or animal product from horses.

disinfect means bathe with a disinfectant chemical or heat, irradiate, fumigate or otherwise treat so as to destroy all Equine influenza virus present.

fittings means any stall, box, cage, enclosure, pen or material used for penning, yarding or the containing of any horses, and includes any equipment, harness, saddlery, rope, bucket, trough, bedding, utensil and implement used in the handling, keeping, treatment, care of or storage of horses, animal products from horses or fodder.

Restricted Area (Red) means any restricted area that is known as a Restricted Area (Red) that has been declared, or may be declared, pursuant to section 15 of the Act, in relation to the exotic disease Equine influenza.

EXOTIC DISEASES OF ANIMALS ACT 1991

Equine influenza

General Permit to move specified animal products, fodder, fittings and vehicles out of, into or within a Special Restricted Area (HATCHED) (section 24)

To all persons in New South Wales,

Pursuant to section 24 of the Exotic Diseases of Animals Act 1991 ("the Act") I hereby permit:

- (a) the things specified in Schedule 1, subject to the conditions specified in Schedule 1; and
- (b) the things specified in Schedule 2, subject to the conditions specified in Schedule 2

to be moved out of, into or within any Special Restricted Area (Hatched)

SCHEDULE 1

Specified Things

All animal products from horses that are:

- (a) chilled or frozen semen or embryos from horses,
- (b) blood, urine or other diagnostic samples from horses that are:
 - (i) taken directly to a diagnostic laboratory, and
 - (ii) either held or disposed of in a manner approved under Australian Standards for the secure disposal of biological waste,

SCHEDULE 2

Specified Things

- 1. All fodder that has not been in; and
- 2. All vehicles and fittings that have been cleaned and disinfected after contact with, or use in connection with, any horse or any animal products from horses except those animal products from horses specified in Schedule 1

Definitions

In this Permit:

contact means touching or coming within twenty metres of any horse or animal product from horses.

disinfect means bathe with a disinfectant chemical or heat, irradiate, fumigate or otherwise treat so as to destroy all Equine influenza virus present.

fittings means any stall, box, cage, enclosure, pen or material used for penning, yarding or the containing of any horses, and includes any equipment, harness, saddlery, rope, bucket, trough, bedding, utensil and implement used in the handling, keeping, treatment, care of or storage of horses, animal products from horses or fodder.

Special Restricted Area (Hatched) means any restricted area that is known as a Special Restricted Area (Hatched) that has been declared, or may be declared, pursuant to section 15 of the Act, in relation to the exotic disease Equine influenza.
