Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Motor Vehicles Taxation Regulation 2003* to recognise that the amount of taxes paid under the *Motor Vehicles Taxation Act 1988* that may be refunded on surrender of registration may be calculated on the basis of the number of whole days of registration that are unexpired when a vehicle was stolen or involved in an incident that caused it to be damaged.

This Regulation is made under the *Motor Vehicles Taxation Act 1988*, including sections 13 (b) and 23 (the general regulation-making power).

- (b) in any other case—the number of whole unexpired days of the registration period of the vehicle concerned on the date on which the Authority cancels the registration of the vehicle.

PURSUANT to section 66(1) of the Casino Control Act 1992, the Casino Control Authority does, by this Order, approve the following amendments to the rules for the playing of the games of "Baccarat", "Big Wheel", "Blackjack", "Caribbean Stud Poker", "Charity Tournament Poker", "Craps", "Double Chance", "Four Card Poker", "Let It Ride", "Pai Gow", "Poker", "Roulette", "Sic Bo", "Three Card Baccarat", "Three Card Poker" and "Two Up" in the casino operated by Star City Pty Limited under licence granted by the Casino Control Authority on 14 December 1994:

(1) Amendments to the rules for the playing of "Baccarat"

- (a) Baccarat sub-rule 2.2 is repealed and in substitution therefor, the following new sub-rule 2.2 is approved:
 - 2.2 The layout cloth covering the table shall display the name and/or logo of the casino, or the name and/or logo of the Private Gaming Rooms, shall have areas designated for the placement of wagers by both seated and standing players and shall be marked in a manner substantially similar to that shown in diagram "A", "B", "C", "D", "E", "F", "G", "H", "I", "J" or "K" and having numbered spaces for between 6 and 14 seated players.

(2) Amendments to the rules for the playing of "Big Wheel"

- (a) Big Wheel sub-rule 2.3 is repealed and in substitution therefor, the following new sub-rule 2.3 is approved:
 - 2.3 The layout of the table shall display the name and/or logo of the casino, or the name and/or logo of the Private Gaming Rooms, shall have areas designated for the placement of wagers and shall be marked in a manner substantially similar to that shown in diagram "B" or "C".

(3) Amendments to the rules for the playing of "Blackjack"

- (a) Blackjack sub-rule 2.2.5 is repealed and in substitution therefor, the following new sub-rule 2.2.5 is approved:
 - 2.2.5 the name and/or logo of the casino imprinted thereon, or the name and/or logo of the Private Gaming Rooms imprinted thereon.

(4) Amendments to the rules for the playing of "Caribbean Stud Poker"

- (a) Caribbean Stud Poker sub-rule 2.2.4 is repealed and in substitution therefor, the following new sub-rule 2.2.4 is approved:
 - 2.2.4 the name and/or logo of the casino imprinted thereon, or the name and/or logo of the Private Gaming Rooms imprinted thereon.

(5) Amendments to the rules for the playing of "Charity Tournament Poker"

Administrative Schemes Relating To

The Frank Hutchens Scholarship and The Hutchens-Evans
Trust

FRANK HUTCHENS was a Professor of the Sydney Conservatorium of Music. He established the Hutchens Trust by his will dated 28 February 1957. The purpose of the Hutchens Trust was to provide 'a scholarship for the study of musical composition'.

The Hutchens Trust is not currently being used, for reasons which include 'the difficulty of locating people to serve on the committee' and because the Fund 'does not produce sufficient income to allow the granting of scholarships every year'. The scholarship has not been awarded for a number of years.

The Hutchens-Evans Trust was settled in 1966 from funds raised from the Hutchens and Evans Concert Fund. Mr Lindley Evans and Mr Frank Hutchens performed the concerts and the proceeds from the concerts and various other donations comprised the Concert Fund. The Fund's purpose was to 'raise and provide moneys to assist students of music in furthering their musical education in such manner as the Executive Committee should in their discretion think fit'. The Trustee states that the Hutchens-Evans Trust 'does not produce sufficient income to allow the granting of scholarships each year'.

The ANZ Executor and Trustee Company ('the Trustee') proposed that the Attorney General establish an administrative scheme in relation to each of the Hutchens Trust and the Hutchens-Evans Trust. The Trustee seeks to vary certain aspects of the manner or mode of administration of the Trusts so as to enhance the Trustee's ability to achieve the purpose of the Trusts.

In relation to the Hutchens Trust, the Trustee proposes an administrative scheme which will provide the Trustee with:

- 1. flexibility in the selection of an Advisory Committee of suitable expertise and calibre;
- 2. the power to increase the value of the prize, rather than it being a fixed amount;
- 3. the power to capitalise the accumulated income either on a 'once –off' basis or at the Trustee's discretion in the future.

In relation to the Hutchens-Evans Trust, the Trustee proposes an administrative scheme which will provide the Trustee with:

- 1. flexibility in the selection of an Advisory Committee of suitable expertise and calibre;
- the power to award the scholarship 'from time to time', rather than each year and therefore to have the power to reserve income;
- 3. the power to capitalise the accumulated income either on a 'once-off' basis or at the Trustee's discretion in the future

I have formed the view that the Hutchens and Hutchens-Evans Trusts disclose a general charitable intent and are trusts for charitable purposes. I have approved a recommendation that the Attorney General establish administrative schemes in respect of each Trust pursuant to section 12(1)(b) of the Charitable Trusts Act 1993 to extend and vary the powers of the Trustees and to prescribe and vary the manner and mode of administration of each of the Trusts.

Therefore, pursuant to section 12 of the Charitable Trusts Act, I hereby order administrative schemes in terms of the above, such order to take effect 21 days after the publication of this Order in the Government Gazette, in accordance with section 16(2) of the Charitable Trusts Act.

1. The operation of a 250 mega-litre per day desalination plant on the Kurnell Peninsula for the supply of an annual daily average production of up to 250 mega-litres of drinking water per day (scaleable to 500 mega-litres per day), to commence once the desalination plant is constructed. The desalination plant will be powered 100 per cent by accredited renewable energy. The desalination plant will operate at maximum available capacity during the initial two year proving period, after which period the plant will operate in accordance with an operating regime agreed to by Government.

Reasons:

It is vitally important to secure Sydney's water supply for the benefit of the whole community.

Historically most of Sydney's water supply has been rainfall dependent. The current prolonged drought has therefore required greater consideration of non-rainfall dependent water sources, such as desalination.

Sydney's water storage levels fell to record lows in February 2006 and the Government determined that it was necessary to initiate construction of a desalination plant at Kurnell in order to secure Sydney's water supplies.

Sydney Water has signed the contract to construct the desalination plant with BlueWater Joint Venture, consisting of Veolia Water and John Holland Group Pty Ltd. A separate contract to construct the water pipeline from Kurnell to Erskineville was awarded to the Water Delivery Alliance, consisting of Bovis Lend Lease, McConnell Dowell, Kellogg Brown & Root, Patterson Britton & Partners and Environmental Resources Management.

The contracts for the desalination plant provide for a two year 'proving period' to ensure the desalination operates as intended. Ensuring that the desalination plant is able to perform as intended is of utmost importance to achieve the Government's objective of securing Sydney's water supplies and ensuring that the value of the investment in desalination is realised.

Following the initial proving period, the plant will be operated in accordance with an operating regime to be determined by the Government. Operating the plant as part of an integrated water supply system will ensure that Sydney can secure its water supplies in the face of drought, population growth and the potential impacts of climate change.

Purchase of 100% accredited renewable energy will mean that there is no net greenhouse impact arising from the electricity used to power the desalination plant. Planning approval is contingent on this green energy purchase.

The Rosehill (Camellia) Recycled Water Project is a major component of the 2006 Metropolitan Water Plan that outlines Government's plans to secure Sydney's water supply to at least 2015. The Plan demonstrates the Government's commitment to recycling and provides that by 2015, 70 billion litres of water will be recycled per year. This represents 11 per cent of Sydney's water supply.

The Rosehill (Camellia) Recycled Water Project will initially provide 4.3 billion litres per year of recycled water to industrial and irrigation customers as a replacement for drinking water. The Project could provide an additional 3 billion litres per year of recycled water in the future and is a key recycled water component of the Plan.

Increasing the use of recycled water can reduce Sydney's reliance on variable rainfall and improve the security of water suppliers in the face of droughts, population growth and the potential impacts of climate change.
