1 Name of Order

This Order is the *Independent Pricing and Regulatory Tribunal (Passenger Transport Services) Amendment Order 2010*.

2 Amendment of Independent Pricing and Regulatory Tribunal (Passenger Transport Services) Order 1998

Insert after clause 3:

4 Exclusion of services from declaration

- (1) The transport passenger services supplied in accordance with any of the following MyZone tickets are also excluded from any declaration under clause 3:
 - (a) MyTrain 28-day RailPass (including concession),
 - (b) MyTrain 365-day RailPass (including concession),
 - (c) MyTrain Child Off-peak Return,
 - (d) MyMulti Day Pass.
- (2) Subclause (1) ceases to have effect:
 - (a) 12 months after the commencement of this clause, or
 - (b) on the date on which Schedule 1 to the *CityRail Final Determination No 4, 2008* is replaced by a determination of the Tribunal under Part 3 of the *Independent Pricing and Regulatory Tribunal Act 1992*,
whichever is the later.
