**VEHICLE SAFETY COMPLIANCE CERTIFICATION SCHEME INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS
ORDER 2011**

under the

I, PETER DUNCAN, Chief Executive of Roads and Maritime Services, pursuant to Clause 76AM(1)(b) of the Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Regulation 2007, make the following Order.

Explanatory Note:

The object of this Order is to establish the requirements of Roads and Maritime Services under clause 76AM(1)(b) of the Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Regulation 2007 (the Regulation) which a person must satisfy to establish that they hold the required insurance.

1. Name of Order

This Order is the Vehicle Safety Compliance Certification Scheme Insurance Requirements Order 2011.

2. Commencement

This Order commences on the date on which it is published in the *New South Wales Government Gazette*.

3. Effect

This Order remains in force until it is revoked.

4. Interpretation

Words and expressions used in this Order have the same meaning as those defined in the Regulation.

5. Insurance Requirements of the Authority

Under clause 76AM(1)(b) of the Regulation, the insurance requirements of Roads and Maritime Services which an applicant for a certifier's licence or renewal of a certifier's licence must satisfy to establish that they hold the required insurance is to hold an insurance policy which contains the following terms:

- (a) The name, address and contact details of the individual insured under the insurance policy and, if appropriate, the company insured under the policy (including the ABN).
- (b) The business description must explicitly cover vehicle certification activities of the individual Vehicle Safety Compliance Certification Scheme licensed certifier and include vehicle inspection, testing, operation and certification that the vehicle complies with the applicable vehicle standards and any other work incidental thereto as undertaken in accordance with Part 5A of the Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Regulation 2007 and the VSCCS Licence Conditions for Licensed Certifiers.
- (c) The period of insurance, being a minimum of 12 months.
- (d) The limits of liability being a minimum of:
 - (i) combined liability with \$20 million public liability insurance for any one claim or series of claims arising from one occurrence; and
 - (ii) \$5 million professional indemnity insurance for any one claim or series of claims arising from one event and in the annual aggregate for all claims combined during the period of insurance.
- (e) Roads and Maritime Services must be a named insured under the combined liability policy for public liability or indemnified under the insurance policy for public liability.
- (f) If the policy is held in a company name, a natural person who has made an application for a certifier's licence or renewal of a certifier's licence must be a named insured.
- (g) The insurance policy must cover each person for the certification of vehicles or vehicle modifications in accordance with Part 5A of the Regulation, the VSCCS Conditions of Licence for Licensed Certifiers and any other activity incidental thereto. The certification of vehicles and vehicle modifications work covered must be to NSW applicable vehicle standards.
- (h) The insurance cover must be provided by an Australian Prudential Regulation Authority approved insurer.
