# SPECIAL SUPPLEMENT

### **AQUATIC RESERVES NOTIFICATION 2013**

under the Fisheries Management Act 1994

I, the Minister for Primary Industries, in pursuance of sections 197E-197H of the Fisheries Management Act 1994, make the following Notification.

#### 1. Name of Notification

This Notification is the Aquatic Reserves Notification 2013.

#### 2. Commencement

This Notification commences on 1 September 2013.

## 3. Revocation of previous notification

The notification titled "Section 197E – Aquatic Reserve Notification" dated 14 September 2011 and published in the *Government Gazette* No. 91 dated 16 September 2011 at page 5570 is revoked.

#### 4. Prohibition of activities

The activities specified in Column 2 of Schedule 1 are prohibited in the aquatic reserves specified opposite in Column 1 of Schedule 1.

Barrenjoey Head Boat Harbour Bronte-Coogee Cape Banks Narrabeen Head	<ul> <li>a) The taking of the tunicate 'cunjevoi' – <i>Pyura</i> spp., and all invertebrates (including anemones, barnacles, chitons, cockles, crabs, mussels, octopus, oysters, pipis, sea urchins, sea stars, snails, worms) with the exception of eastern rocklobster (<i>Sagmariasus verreauxi</i>), southern rocklobster (<i>Jasus edwardsii</i>) and blacklip abalone (<i>Haliotis rubra rubra</i>).</li> <li>b) Collecting, destroying or interfering with any marine vegetation, with the exception of sea lettuce (<i>Ulva lactuca</i>) and bait weed (<i>Enteromorpha intestinalis</i>).</li> </ul>
Cabbage Tree Bay	Taking, gathering, destroying, injuring or interfering with any fish or marine vegetation (whether dead or alive).

Long Reef	Taking, gathering, destroying, injuring or interfering with any fish or marine vegetation (whether dead or alive), other than taking finfish using hand held lines or spear guns.
Shiprock	<ul><li>a) Taking, gathering, destroying, injuring or interfering with any fish or marine vegetation (whether dead or alive).</li><li>b) Constructing, using or operating a jetty or slipway other than a jetty or slipway that was lawfully</li></ul>
	constructed and in existence immediately before 1 September 2002.
North Harbour	Taking, gathering, destroying, injuring or interfering with any fish or marine vegetation (whether dead or alive), other than taking finfish using hand held lines.
Bushranger's Bay	Taking, gathering, destroying, injuring or interfering with any fish or marine vegetation (whether dead or alive).
Towra Point	Taking, gathering, destroying, injuring or interfering with any fish or marine vegetation (whether dead or alive), other than taking fish using hand held lines or lawful recreational nets from that part of Towra Point Aquatic Reserve referred to as the refuge zone shown in Schedule 2.

#### In this Schedule:

Barrenjoey Head Aquatic Reserve, Boat Harbour Aquatic Reserve, Bronte-Coogee Aquatic Reserve, Cabbage Tree Bay Aquatic Reserve, Cape Banks Aquatic Reserve and Narrabeen Head Aquatic Reserve mean the aquatic reserves declared pursuant to section 194 of the Fisheries Management Act 1994, titled "Declaration of Aquatic Reserves" dated 31 March 2002 and published in Government Gazette No. 65 on 22 March 2002 at page 1731-1732.

**Bushranger's Bay Aquatic Reserve** means the aquatic reserve declared pursuant to section 194 of the Fisheries Management Act 1994 and published in *Government Gazette* No. 65 of 14 May 1982 at page 2104.

*Cook Island Aquatic Reserve* means the aquatic reserve declared pursuant to section 194 of the Fisheries Management Act 1994 and published in *Government Gazette* No. 152 on 23 October 1998 at page 8435.

*finfish* means bony fish (Osteichthyes) and cartilaginous fish (Chondrichthyes).

fish has the same meaning as it has in the Fisheries Management Act 1994.


hand held line, lawful recreational net and spear gun have the same meaning as they have in the Fisheries Management (General) Regulation 2010.

Long Reef Aquatic Reserve means the aquatic reserve declared pursuant to section 194 of the Fisheries Management Act 1994 and published in *Government Gazette* No. 80 of 30 May 1980 at page 2787.

*North Harbour Aquatic Reserve* means the aquatic reserve declared pursuant to section 194 of the Fisheries Management Act 1994 and published in *Government Gazette* No. 46 of 26 March 1982 at page 1336.

*Shiprock Aquatic Reserve* means the aquatic reserve declared pursuant to section 194 of the Fisheries Management Act 1994 and published in *Government Gazette* No. 46 of 26 March 1982 at page 1336.

*Towra Point Aquatic Reserve* means the aquatic reserve declared pursuant to section 194 of the Fisheries Management Act 1994 and published in *Government Gazette* No. 49 of 12 April 1990 at page 3070.
