#### SUSPENSION OF PUMPING IN THE STEWARTS RIVER AND ITS TRIBUTARIES (No. 1) 2014

under Section 22B of the Water Act 1912

I, Vickie Chatfield, having delegated authority from the Water Administration Ministerial Corporation, in pursuance of section 22B of the Water Act 1912, being satisfied that the quantity of water available in the Stewarts River and its tributaries is insufficient to meet all requirements with respect to the taking of water from the river, make the following Notice.

#### **Explanatory note**

This Notice is made under section 22B of the Water Act 1912. The object of this Notice is to suspend the right to pump water for all holders of permits, authorities, licences and group licences in the Stewarts River and its tributaries with the exception of permits, authorities, licences and group licences for water supply for town water supply, stock, domestic and farming (fruit washing and dairy washdown) purposes.

## Suspension of Pumping in the Stewarts River and its Tributaries (No. 1) 2014

under Section 22B of the Water Act 1912

#### 1. Name of Notice

This Notice is the Suspension of pumping in the Stewarts River and its tributaries (No. 1) 2014.

### 2. Commencement

This Notice commences on the day on which it is published in the NSW Government Gazette and in a newspaper circulating in the district in which the Stewarts River and its tributaries are located.

#### 3. Period

This Notice will remain in force until repealed or modified by further notice.

# 4. Suspension of pumping

The right to pump water is suspended for all holders of permits, authorities, licences and group licences in the Stewarts River and its tributaries under Part 2 of the Water Act 1912 from Thursday, 23 January 2014, subject to Clause 5.

### 5. Exclusions

This Notice does not apply to water supply for town water supply, stock, domestic and farming (fruit washing and dairy washdown) purposes.
