I, Peter Turnell, Acting Executive Director, Fisheries NSW, with the delegated authority of the Minister for Primary Industries and the Secretary of the Department of Trade and Investment, Regional Infrastructure and Services pursuant to sections 227 and 228 of the Fisheries Management Act 1994, do by this notification, prohibit the taking of fish by the methods of fishing specified in Column 1 of the Schedule below, from the waters described opposite in Column 2 of that Schedule.





Order under Section 12

Cy-Pres Scheme Relating to the Police Benevolent Fund

SECTION 9 (1) of the Charitable Trusts Act 1993 permits the application of property cy-pres where the spirit of the original trust can no longer be implemented.

The Police Benevolent Fund (the Fund) was created in the late 1920s or early 1930s following a bequest. Its purposes appear to have evolved in the initial stages of its existence. At the time when the Fund became inactive, in around 2003, its purpose was to provide financial assistance to police officers

and former police officers and/or their dependants who were in 'necessitous circumstances'. Although the Fund existed for the benefit of a specified class of individuals, it can be characterised as a charitable trust as it existed for the relief of poverty and was not subscription based.

The Fund is not currently being applied for its purpose, due to the absence of any serving police office bearers and no certainty regarding the applicable rules for administering the Fund. While there are still serving and current police officers and their dependants who are in need, given the evolution of the Fund over time, it is not possible to state with certainty what the current purposes of the Fund are. As such, the current purposes of the Fund, whatever they may be, have ceased to provide a suitable and effective means of using the trust property.

The assets of the Fund are held by the New South Wales Police Bank and amount to approximately \$152,824.88 (as at June 2012).

In the absence of the Attorney General from New South Wales, I have formed a view that the trust property is a fund for a charitable purpose. I consider that the original charitable purpose has failed and that this is an appropriate matter in which the Attorney General should approve a cy-pres scheme under section 12 (1) (a) of the Charitable Trusts Act 1993.

The cy près scheme would require that the trust property will be transferred to Police Legacy Limited as the new trustee and that the income of the Fund be applied for the purpose of granting assistance to members or retired members, or to the dependant/s of members or retired members of the New South Wales Police Force, who are in necessitous circumstances. The necessitous circumstances are not to be relieved if they have arisen through an individual's misconduct.

Under section 12 (1) (a) of the Charitable Trusts Act 1993 I hereby order that the Trust property comprising the Police Benevolent Fund be applied cy près for this charitable purpose.

This Order will take effect 21 days after its publication in the *New South Wales Government Gazette*, in accordance with section 16 (2) of the Charitable Trusts Act 1993.


