ENERGY AND UTILITIES ADMINISTRATION (ENERGY CONTRIBUTIONS) ORDER 2015

I, Mark Speakman SC, MP, Minister for the Environment, with the concurrence of the Hon Anthony Roberts, MP, Minister for Industry, Resources and Energy, and the Hon Gladys Berejiklian, MP, Treasurer, make the following Order under section 34J of the *Energy and Utilities Administration Act 1987*.

This Order takes effect on the date that it is published in the Gazette.

Explanatory note

Section 34J of the *Energy and Utilities Administration Act 1987* provides that the Minister may, by order published in the Gazette, require any one or more distribution network service providers to make an annual contribution for a specified financial year to the Climate Change Fund. The purpose of this Order is to require defined distribution network service providers to make an annual contribution to the Climate Change Fund for the financial year commencing 1 July 2015.

1. Name of Order

This Order is the *Energy and Utilities Administration (Energy Contributions) Order 2015*.

2. Commencement

This Order commences on the date that it is published in the Gazette.

3. Interpretation

The Explanatory Note to this Order does not form part of the Order.

4. Definitions

distribution network service provider means a distribution network service provider listed in column 1 of Schedule 1.

5. Annual contribution

- (1) A distribution network service provider is required to make an annual contribution to the Climate Change Fund for the financial year commencing 1 July 2015.
- (2) The amount of the annual contribution to be paid by a distribution network service provider is as set out in column 2 of Schedule 1.

6. Time for payment

The annual contribution is to be paid by quarterly instalments (each being equal to one-fourth of the annual contribution payable) on or before the first day of August 2015, November 2015, February 2016 and May 2016.
