## PASSENGER TRANSPORT ACT 2014

#### **ORDER**

Section 39

Exemption of Certain Public Passenger Services from the Requirement to be Operated under the Authority of a Passenger Service Contract

Rail Services Contract Transition Exemption Order

I, Timothy Reardon, Secretary of the Department of Transport, on behalf of Transport for NSW, under section 39 (4) of the *Passenger Transport Act 2014*, exempt a public passenger service satisfying the description below from the requirement to be operated under the authority of a passenger service contract.

#### **Object**

The object of this order is to continue as a transitional measure under the *Passenger Transport Act 2014* the treatment of public passenger services by train that under the *Passenger Transport Act 1990* were not required to be carried out under a rail services contract, that requirement being only applicable to Rail Corporation New South Wales and its public subsidiary corporations NSW Trains and Sydney Trains.

### Description of public passenger service

A public passenger service by train conducted according to regular routes and timetables or according to regular routes and at regular intervals by a person or organisation that is an accredited person other than a public passenger service operated by the following:

**NSW Trains** 

Rail Corporation New South Wales

**Sydney Trains** 

## Interpretation

In this Order:

accredited person has the same meaning as in the Rail Safety National Law (NSW)

NSW Trains means the corporation with that name continued in existence by the Transport Administration (General) Regulation 2013

Rail Corporation New South Wales means the corporation of with that name constituted by the Transport Administration Act 1988

**Sydney Trains** means the corporation with that name continued in existence by the *Transport Administration (General)* Regulation 2013

#### **Publication**

This Order is required to be published in the Gazette.

### **Date of Effect and Termination**

This Order takes effect on 1 March 2016 and will continue in force until revoked.

This Order may be revoked at any time by Transport for NSW.
