NEW SOUTH WALES to wit (L.S) M Beazley, Governor.	By Her Excellency the Honourable Margaret Beazley AO QC, Governor of the State of New South Wales in the Commonwealth of Australia.

Whereas Her Majesty has been graciously pleased, by Commission under Her Royal Sign Manual and the Public Seal of the State, bearing date at Saint James's the tenth day of January two thousand and nineteen, to appoint me Margaret Joan Beazley, Officer of the Order of Australia, Queen's Counsel, to be Governor in and over the State of New South Wales in the Commonwealth of Australia: Now, therefore, I, the Governor aforesaid, do hereby proclaim and declare that I have this day taken the prescribed Oaths before the Honourable Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the said State, and that I have assumed the said office of Governor accordingly.

Greeting;

- I. We do, by this Our Commission under Our Sign Manual and the Public Seal of the State of New South Wales, appoint you, the said Honourable Justice Margaret Joan Beazley, Officer of the Order of Australia and Queen's Counsel, to be, during Our pleasure, Our Governor in and over Our State of New South Wales in the Commonwealth of Australia, with all the powers, rights, privileges and advantages to the said Office belonging or appertaining.
- II. And We do hereby authorise, empower and command you to exercise and perform all and singular the powers and functions appertaining to the said Office contained in the Constitution Act, 1902, of the said State, the Australia Act, 1986, of the Commonwealth of Australia, and the Australia Act, 1986, of the United Kingdom.
- III. Further We do hereby appoint that so soon as you shall have taken the Oaths prescribed by the said Constitution Act, 1902, and have entered upon the duties of your Office, this Our present Commission shall supersede the Commission under Our Sign Manual and the Public Seal of the State of New South Wales bearing date the 8th day of May, 2014 appointing our Trusty and Well-beloved General David Hurley, Companion of Our Order of Australia, upon whom has been conferred the Distinguished Service Cross, to be Governor of Our State of New South Wales.
- IV. And we do hereby command all and singular Our Officers, Ministers and loving subjects in Our said State, and all others whom it may concern, to take due notice hereof and to give their ready obedience accordingly.
