SUBORDINATE LEGISLATION ACT 1989

Notice under Section 5 of the Subordinate Legislation Act 1989 Remaking of the Aboriginal Land Rights Regulation 2014

Section 10(2)(a) of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1989*, provides that a statutory rule published on or after 1 September 1990, is to be repealed and 'remade' every five years. The *Aboriginal Land Rights Regulation 2014*, which is a statutory rule, is currently being reviewed for remaking on 1 September 2020.

As part of the consultation process to remake the *Aboriginal Land Rights Regulation 2014*, interested persons and groups are invited to provide comments and submissions by **9 October 2019**.

Any submission marked "confidential" will be determined in accordance with the *Government Information (Public Access) Act 2009*.
