# **Public Health (COVID-19 Air Transportation Quarantine) Amendment Order 2020**

### **Explanatory note**

The object of this Order is to deal with the public health risk of COVID-19 and its possible consequences.

### Public Health (COVID-19 Air Transportation Quarantine) Amendment Order 2020

#### 1 Name of Order

This Order is the *Public Health (COVID-19 Air Transportation Quarantine)* Amendment Order 2020.

### 2 Amendment of Public Health (COVID-19 Air Transportation Quarantine) Order 2020

The Public Health (COVID-19 Air Transportation Quarantine) Order 2020 is amended by inserting the following after clause 10—

### 11 Transitional arrangements

- (1) This clause applies to a person who was subject to a direction under clause 5 of the *Public Health (COVID-19 Quarantine) Order 2020* if the person's quarantine period had not ended immediately before this Order commenced.
- (2) To remove any doubt, the person must continue to comply with the direction until the quarantine period has ended.
