[1] Clause 3 Definitions

Insert in alphabetical order in clause 3(1)—

essential care service means providing or receiving care or assistance to a vulnerable person, including—

- (a) personal care, and
- (b) mental health or domestic violence services, and
- (c) services to victims of crime.

[2] Clause 3(1)

Omit "health services." in the definition of *permitted purpose*. Insert instead—

health services,

(d) an essential care service.
