Explanatory note

The object of this Order is to provide that a person who has self-isolated after being diagnosed with COVID-19 is exempt from further self-isolation for a period of 12 weeks if the person becomes a close contact or a household contact.

1 Name of Order

This Order is the *Public Health (COVID-19 Self-Isolation) Order Amendment (No 1) Order 2022*.

2 Amendment of Public Health (COVID-19 Self-Isolation) Order 2022

(1) Clause 8 Persons who reside with diagnosed persons

Omit “8 weeks’ from clause 8(2), note. Insert instead “12 weeks”.

(2) Clause 9 Close contacts of persons diagnosed with COVID-19 must self-isolate

Omit “8 weeks” from clause 9(8)(b). Insert instead “12 weeks”.
