## ***Subordinate Legislation Act 1989***

### ***Remake of the Sydney Opera House Trust By-law 2015***

NOTICE is given in accordance with Section 5 of the above Act of the intention to remake the *Sydney Opera House Trust By-law 2015* under the *Sydney Opera House Trust Act 1961*.

Under the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1989*, the Sydney Opera House is required to remake its By-law every five years. The proposed *Sydney Opera House Trust By-law 2021* (draft 2021 By-law) includes the following objectives:

- Health, safety and security of people on the Opera House precinct;
- Protection of the fabric of the Opera House and its contents;
- Protection of the Opera House brand and its image as a national icon, major tourist attraction and meeting place;
- Managing access to the Opera House building and precinct;
- Protection of revenues;
- Effective management of the Opera House and its staff;
- Support for the Opera House as a cultural leader and world-class performing arts centre; and
- Provision of memorable and enjoyable visitor experiences.

The draft 2021 By-law will be on public exhibition between Wednesday 7 April 2021 and Thursday 6 May 2021.
