1. Name of Instrument

This Instrument is the Fisheries Management (Fishing Determination – Eastern Rock Lobster) Notification 2021.

2. Interpretation

In this Instrument:

Lobster Fishery means the share management fishery of that name, as described in Schedule 1 to the Act.

Lobster Plan means the Appendix to the Fisheries Management (Lobster Share Management Plan) Regulation 2000.

eastern rock lobster means the species Sagmaraisus verreauxi.

TAC determination has the same meaning as in section 40A of the Act.
