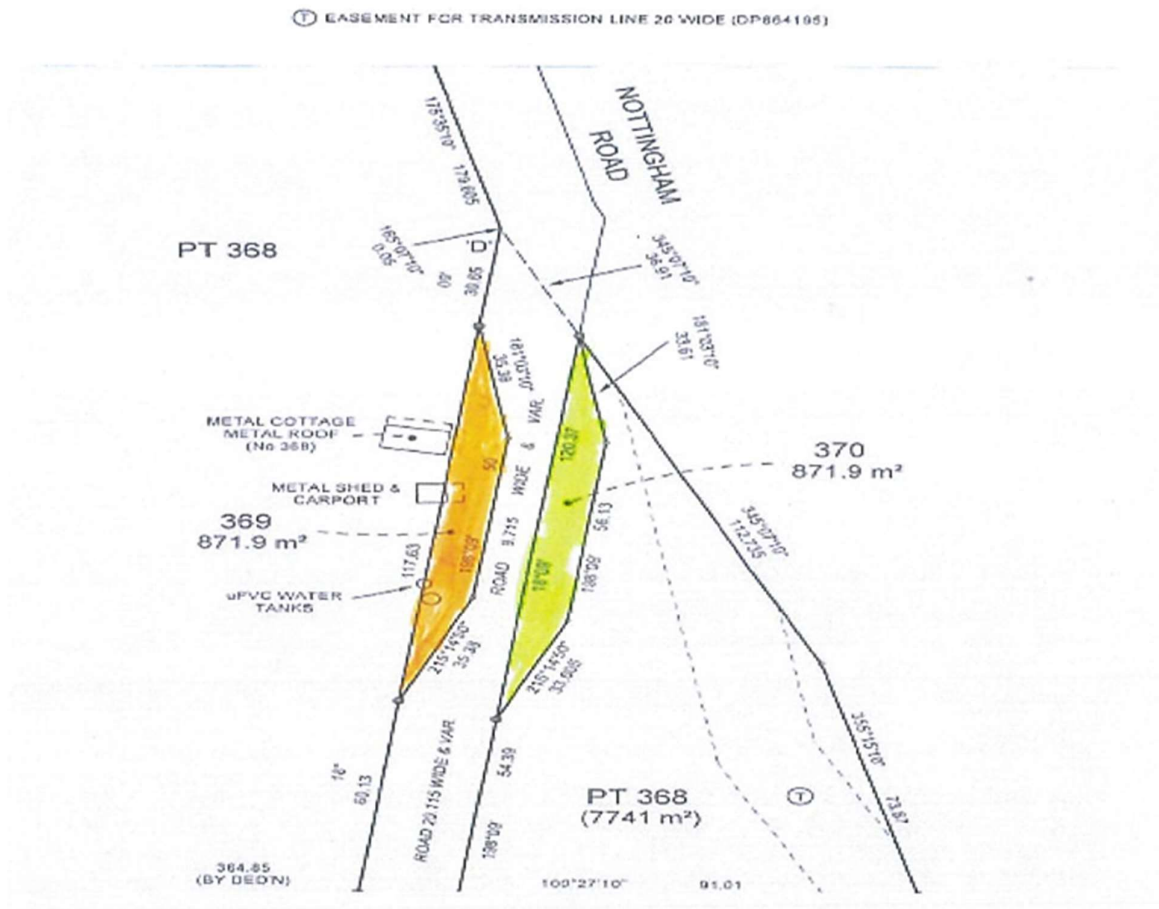

REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONE

Location

Camden Haven River, North Haven – approximately 200m south east of the North Haven boat ramp, North Haven

Duration

- 6:00pm to 6:10pm – Saturday 10 July 2021

Detail

Fireworks displays will be conducted over the navigable waters of the Camden Haven River, North Haven at the location specified above. Fireworks will be launched from a moored firing barge at the above location. The area directly around this firing position may be dangerous and hazardous to other waterway users while fireworks are being launched.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event, extending 150 metres around the firing barge moored approximately 200m south east of the North Haven boat ramp, North Haven. This zone will be indicated by the presence of control vessels which will be stationed on the boundary.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the exclusion zone.

Penalties may apply (Section 12(5) - *Marine Safety Act 1998*)

MINISTERIAL ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 19

Ministerial (Bus and Transit Lane Exemption) Order 2021 No.2

I, Andrew Constance, Minister for Transport and Roads, pursuant to section 19(1) of the *Road Transport Act 2013* (NSW), make the following Order.

1 Name of Order

This Order is the ***Ministerial (Bus and Transit Lane Exemption) Order 2021 No 2.***

2 Commencement

This Order has effect on and from the date of publication in the NSW Government Gazette.

3 Effect

This Order remains in force up to and including 1 January 2022 unless revoked earlier.

4 Interpretation

Words and expressions used in this Order have the same meaning as in the *Road Transport Act 2013* unless otherwise stated.

5 Application

This Order applies to a driver driving a ***hire vehicle*** (within the meaning of the *Point to Point Transport (Taxis and Hire Vehicles) Act 2016*) to which is affixed a HC number-plate issued by Transport for NSW while the vehicle is being used for the purpose of providing a passenger service under that Act.

6 Declaration

The following NSW Road Rules are declared not to apply:

- (a) Road Rule 154(1) driving in a Bus Lane other than a “Bus Only” or “Buses Only” lane.
- (b) Road Rule 156(1) driving in a Transit Lane.

7 Repeal of previous Order

The *Ministerial (Bus and Transit Lane Exemption) Order 2021* published in *NSW Government Gazette No 105 (Roads and Transport)* of 12 March 2021 on pages 2 to 3 is hereby repealed on and from the commencement of this Order.

8 Publication

The Order is to be published in the NSW Government Gazette.

Explanatory note:

The object of this Order is to continue an exemption for drivers of hire vehicles with a HC number-plate issued by Transport for NSW from restrictions on the use of bus lanes and transit lanes under the Road Rules 2014 upon the expiry of Road Rule 158(2)(c)(iia). It does not permit those drivers to drive in a bus only lane.

This Order is made under section 19 of the *Road Transport Act 2013*.

FINANCIAL YEAR 2021-22



(a) \$2,540, for premises within the Category 1 areas; and

(b) \$900, for premises within the Category 2 areas.

ROAD TRANSPORT ACT 2013 – ORDER

The Honorable Margaret Beazley AC QC, Governor.

I, the Honorable Margaret Beazley AC QC, Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and pursuant to the *Road Transport Act 2013* (the Act), do, by this Order, approve the type of traffic enforcement device named in Schedule 1 as being designed for the following uses:

1. **excess speed measurement**, designed to measure the speed at which a vehicle is travelling in accordance with the terms of section 134(1)(a) of the Act;
2. **excess speed imaging**, designed to photograph a vehicle that is driven in excess of a speed limit applicable to a length of road in accordance with the terms of section 134(1)(b) of the Act;

Schedule 1 – Type of device:

The multiple use device, **ACUSENSUS HARMONY MS1**
