Revocation of Interim Heritage Order No 7

Under Section 29 of the Heritage Act 1977, Woollahra Council does by this order:

- revoke the interim heritage order made in respect of the item of the environmental heritage specified or described in Schedule "A", made on 3 September 2021 and published in the New South Wales Government gazette No 430 dated 3 September 2021; and
- ii. declare that the Interim Heritage Order shall no longer apply to the curtilage or site of such item, being the land described in Schedule "B".
