Fireworks displays will be conducted over the navigable waters of Broken Bay specified above, and will be launched from a fireworks barge that will be anchored at the location. The area surrounding this firing position may be dangerous and hazardous while fireworks are being launched.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event and will be marked by control vessels on the perimeter which will be created 200 meters around the fireworks barge.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the exclusion zone which will be monitored by control vessels.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event comprising the entirety of Lake Albert, which will effectively close the Lake to all other vessel use.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the exclusion zone, which will be patrolled by TfNSW Maritime officers.

Talbingo Reservoir, Talbingo

Detail

Trials involving the use of a high speed vessel powered by a jet engine will be conducted on the waters of the Talbingo Reservoir on the dates and times specified above. The jet powered vessel may be operating at very high speeds and will present a significant potential hazard to other waterway users.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event comprising all navigable waters of the Talbingo Reservoir upstream from the Dam Wall for a distance of approximately 9km to Point Monster, immediately downstream of Cat Hole Creek.

The Exclusion Zone includes the navigable extent of all tributaries to Talbingo Reservoir within the limits of the zone such as Landers Creek, and Biggaboy, Trouble, Honeysuckle and Waterfall Bays.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the exclusion zone, which will be monitored by control vessels and event officials on land.
