The object of this Order is to amend the *Public Health (COVID-19 General) Order (No 2) 2021* regarding COVID-19 Safe Check-ins in cases of persons responding to emergencies and persons exercising law enforcement, intelligence or national security functions for the State or Commonwealth Government.

1 Name of Order

This Order is the Public Health (COVID-19 General) Order (No 2) Amendment (No 1) Order 2021.

2 Amendment of Public Health (COVID-19 General) Order (No 2) 2021

Clause 10 Registration of contact details for entry to certain premises

Insert after clause 10(3)—

- (4) Despite subclauses (1)–(3), the following persons are not required to electronically register contact details when entering premises—
 - (a) a person entering the premises in response to an emergency,
 - (b) a person exercising law enforcement, intelligence or national security functions on behalf of a government agency of New South Wales or the Commonwealth.
