2 Amendment of Public Health (COVID-19 General) Order (No 2) Order 2021

Clause 14A

Insert after clause 14—

14A Music festivals prohibited in Newcastle

- (1) An occupier of premises in the City of Newcastle local government area must not allow the premises to be used for the purposes of a music festival.
- (2) A person must not be on premises in the City of Newcastle local government area at which a music festival is being held.
