## Order regarding volunteers taking part in emergency operations

under the State Emergency and Rescue Management Act 1989

I, Daniel Austin, acting Commissioner of the State Emergency Service, in pursuance of section 60D of the *State Emergency and Rescue Management Act 1989*, do, by this my Order, direct that the provisions of Part 3A of that Act apply to emergency operations carried out by the following in connection with the emergency caused by floods and storms in the State:

- (a) all volunteer emergency workers from the State Emergency Service;
- (b) all volunteer rural fire fighters within the meaning of the *Rural Fires Act 1997*;
- (c) all volunteer emergency workers from Surf Life Saving New South Wales;
- (d) all volunteer emergency workers from Volunteer Marine Rescue NSW;
- (e) all volunteer emergency workers from New South Wales Volunteer Rescue Association Inc.

This Order remains in force for 48 hours from the time and date of its publication on the NSW legislation website (unless sooner revoked).
