REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONE

Location

Wyangala Dam – adjacent to Wyangala Waters Holiday and Recreation Park

Duration

8.00am to 6.00pm on the following dates:

- Saturday 19 and Sunday 20 February 2022

Detail

A number of water-skiing races will be conducted on the navigable waters of Wyangala Dam at the dates and time specified above. The event will involve the use of powered vessels and persons being towed at speed, with the possibility of persons in the water from time to time, presenting a significant potential hazard to other waterway users.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event, which will be marked by inflatable buoys and monitored by control vessels stationed on the boundary.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone.

Penalties may apply (section 12(5) - *Marine Safety Act 1998*)

Section 12(2)

REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONE

Location

Hunter River - adjacent to the Endeavour Rowing Club at Berry Park

Duration

7.30am to 5.00pm on the following dates:

- Saturday 19 and Sunday 20 February 2022

Detail

Rowing Regattas will be conducted on the navigable waters of the Hunter River at the location specified above.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the events, which will be marked by buoys and monitored by control vessels.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone.

Transit lane

Provision may be made (where necessary) for a control vessel to authorise local vessel traffic to pass safely through the course via a 'transit lane'.

Special Restrictions

Pursuant to section 12(3) of the *Marine Safety Act 1998*, all vessels using the transit lane:

- Must not exceed the maximum speed limit of 4 knots, and
- Must produce minimal wash.

Penalties may apply (section 12(5) - *Marine Safety Act 1998*)

REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONE

Location

Lake Albert, Wagga Wagga – all navigable waters

Duration

- 8.00am to 6.00pm – Saturday 19 February 2022
- 8.00am to 1.00pm – Sunday 20 February 2022

Detail

Power boat races will be conducted on the navigable waters of Lake Albert as specified above. The event will involve the use of high speed power vessels, presenting a significant potential hazard to other waterway users.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event and will comprise the entirety of Lake Albert as described above.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the exclusion zone which will be maintained and patrolled by support and control vessels.

Penalties may apply (section 12(5) - *Marine Safety Act 1998*)
