I, KARL RIO HAMPTON, Minister for Natural Resources, Environment and Heritage, under section 26(1)(a) of the *Heritage Conservation Act*, declare the Fergusson River Overland Telegraph Line Pylons and Oppenhiemer Telegraph Poles, described in Schedule 1 and depicted on the map in Schedule 2, to be a heritage place.
