



BEE III, AUTOMATIC SAME DIRECTION TRAFFIC RADAR

I, SHAYNE LESTER MAINES, the Acting Commissioner of Police

- (a) pursuant to section 44(1) of the *Traffic Act* and with reference to section 43 of the *Interpretation Act*, revoke the Instrument dated 28 August 2006 appearing in *Gazette* G37 of 13 December 2006 approving the "BEE III, Automatic Same Direction Traffic Radar" as a traffic infringement detection device;

 - (i) the correct operation and accuracy of each BEE III, Automatic Same Direction Traffic Radar is to be tested, not less than once in each day that the device is used for the purposes of the *Act* by a person operating it during that day in accordance with the testing procedures set out in the document

published by the manufacturer of the device and entitled "Operation and Service Manual";

- (ii) the accuracy of the calibration and parameter performance of each BEE III, Automatic Same Direction Traffic Radar is to be tested not less than once in each 12 month period by a person approved under section 44(3) of the Act and sealed shut at the end of the testing procedure; and
- (iii) if the device becomes unsealed, is opened or is otherwise damaged as soon as reasonably practicable after that occurs by a person approved under section 44(3) of the Act.




