NOTIFIABLE DISEASES DECLARATION AND CLASSIFICATION

I, RICHARD PHILIP GALTON, Chief Executive Officer of the Department of Resources:

- (a) under section 30(1) of the *Livestock Act* and section 43 of the *Interpretation Act*:
 - (i) revoke the declaration of "Tuberculosis (*mammalian* or *avian*)" as a notifiable disease, classified as an endemic disease in Schedule 2 of the instrument titled "Notifiable Diseases Declaration and Classification", dated 15 April 2009 and published in *Gazette* G25 of 24 June 2009 (*the 2009 instrument*); and
 - (ii) revoke the declaration of "avian mycoplasmosis (*Mycoplasma synoviae*)" as a notifiable disease,

- classified as an exotic disease in Schedule 3 of the 2009 instrument; and
- (iii) vary the declaration of "East Coast fever" as a notifiable disease, classified as an emergency disease in Schedule 1 of the 2009 instrument, by re describing the disease as "East Coast fever and Mediteranean theileriosis"; and
- (iv) vary the declaration of "trypanosomiasis" as a notifiable disease, classified as an exotic disease in Schedule 3 of the 2009 instrument, by re describing the disease as "trypanosomosis (tsetse fly associated)"; and
- (b) under section 30(1) of the *Livestock Act*;
- (i) declare "Tuberculosis (*Mycobacterium bovis*)" to be a notifiable disease and classify it as an emergency disease; and
- (ii) declare "Avian tuberculosis" and "Cysticercus bovis (*Taenia saginata*)" each to be a notifiable disease and classify them both as endemic diseases; and
- (iii) declare each of the following to be a notifiable disease and classify each as an exotic disease:
- (A) "Epizootic haemorrhagic disease (clinical disease)";
- (B) "Enzootic abortion of ewes";
- (C) "Fowl typhoid";
- (D) "Turkey rhinotracheitis (avian metapneumovirus)".
