Fisheries Regulations FEES AND LEVIES

I, KONSTANTINE VATSKALIS, Minister for Primary Industry, Fisheries and Resources:

- (a) under regulations 206 and 207 of the Fisheries Regulations and with reference to section 43 of the Interpretation Act, revoke the notice prescribing fees and levies under the Fisheries Regulations dated 31 January 2011 and published in Gazette No. S5 on 1 February 2011; and
- (b) under regulation 206(1)(a) of the Fisheries Regulations:
 - prescribe the fee payable for the grant or renewal (i) of a licence specified in Schedule 1 to be the amount specified opposite the licence; and
 - prescribe the fee payable for the grant of a Timor (ii) Reef Fishery licence applied for under regulation 218(1) of the Regulations to be \$3 185; and
 - (iii) prescribe the fee payable for the grant of a Timor Reef Fishery licence applied for under regulation 218(2) of the Regulations to be \$1 592; and
 - (iv) prescribe the fee payable for the grant of a Timor Reef Fishery licence under regulation 141E of the Regulations to be \$1 040; and
 - prescribe the fee payable for the renewal of a (v) Timor Reef Fishery licence to be \$1 040; and
- (c) under regulation 206(1) of the Regulations, prescribe the fee payable for a matter mentioned in Schedule 2 to be the amount specified opposite the matter; and
- (d) under regulation 207(1) of the Fisheries Regulations, prescribe a levy of \$800 to be paid by an applicant for the grant or renewal of a licence listed in Schedule 3 of the Regulations, other than for the grant of a Timor Reef Fishery licence applied for under regulation 218(1) or (2) of the Regulations.

TIMOR REEF FISHERY LICENCE LEVIES

I, GLENN RAYMOND SCHIPP, Director, Fisheries Development, as the delegate of the Northern Territory Fisheries Joint Authority, under regulation 208A(1) of the Fisheries Regulations and with reference to section 38(2) of the Interpretation Act, prescribe the following levies to

be paid by the holder of a Timor Reef Fishery licence on application for renewal of the licence:

- (a) \$0.060 for each fishery unit for goldband snapper attached to the licence;
- (b) \$0.008 for each fishery unit for red snapper attached to the licence;
- (c) \$0.022 for each fishery unit for grouped fish attached to the licence.
