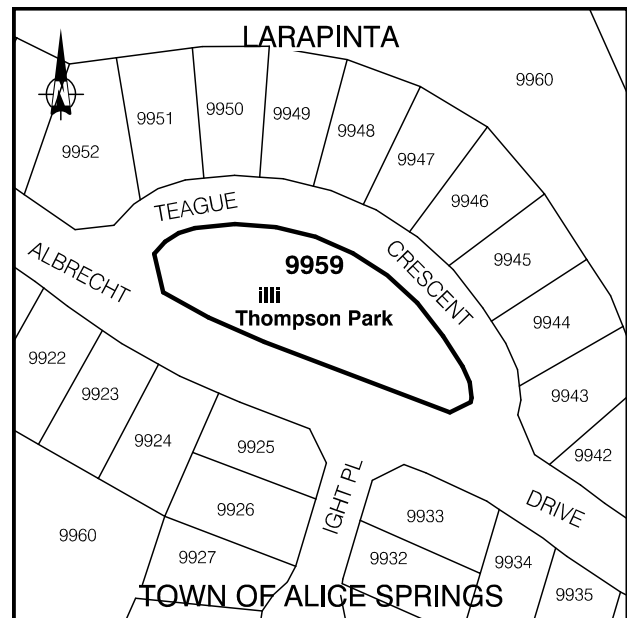

SCHEME MONITORING COMMITTEE

The Committee is constituted under the *Workers Rehabilitation and Compensation Act*, and its functions are:

- (a) to monitor the viability and performance of the workers' compensation scheme;
- (b) to monitor premium rates offered for workers' compensation in the Territory;
- (c) to receive submissions from persons relating to premium rates charged for workers' compensation insurance policies in the Territory or elsewhere;
- (d) to monitor and publish data on overall underwriting results;
- (e) to advise the Minister on the basis of its consideration of information obtained by it; and
- (f) to consider and report on the effectiveness of the premiums offered by insurers
  - (i) in encouraging employers to develop and maintain safe working practices; and
  - (ii) in penalising employers which do not ensure the maintenance of safe working practices.
