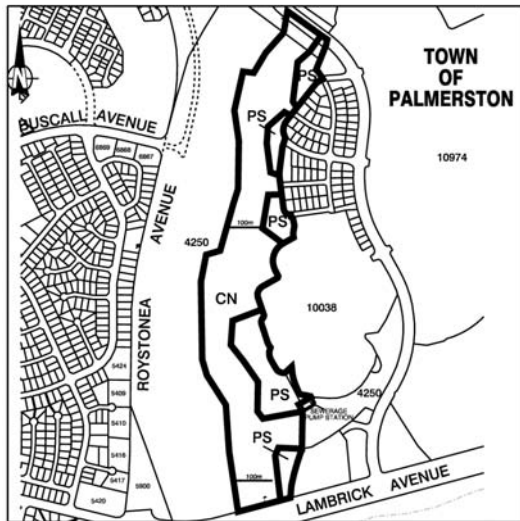

Workers Rehabilitation and Compensation Act

NT WORKSAFE

Scheme Monitoring Committee

Members – Expressions of Interest

Nominations are invited from persons within the Northern Territory who:

- are representatives of organisations representing employees;
- are representatives of organisations representing employers; and
- are representatives of organisations representing insurers.

The Scheme Monitoring Committee comprises of the Executive Director, NT WorkSafe and no more than seven members (one of whom shall be an actuary) appointed by the Minister.

The committee's function is to:

- (a) monitor the viability and performance of the workers' compensation scheme;
- (b) monitor premium rates offered for workers' compensation in the Territory;
- (c) receive submissions from persons relating to premium rates charged for workers' compensation insurance policies in the Territory or elsewhere;
- (d) monitor and publish data on overall underwriting results;
- (e) advise the Minister on the basis of its consideration of information obtained by it; and
- (f) consider and report on the effectiveness of the premiums offered by insurers –
 - (i) in encouraging employers to develop and maintain safe working practices; and
 - (ii) in penalising employers which do not ensure the maintenance of safe working practices.

The term of office is not to exceed two years, as determined by the Minister.
