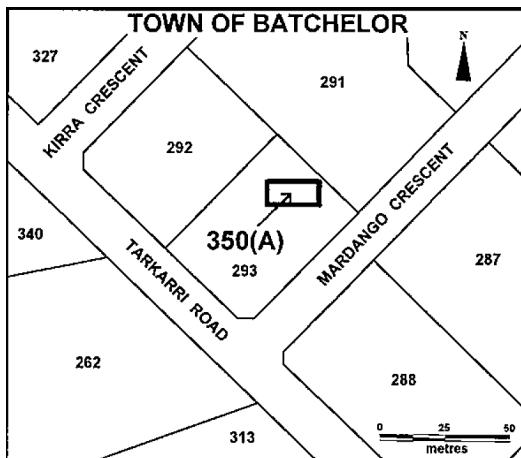

 - (g) a substance that is listed in Schedule 2, 3, 4, or 8 to the *Poisons and Dangerous Drugs Act* and is not specified in Appendix C or D is only to be supplied under the direction or supervision of a medical practitioner, optometrist or a dentist.

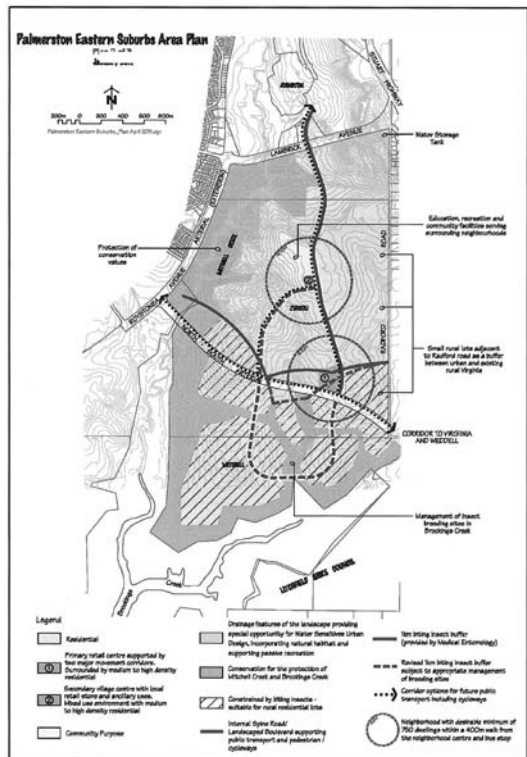
