### DECLARATION OF HERITAGE PLACE REMNANT WWII No. 6 OIL TANK WALL

I, KARL RIO HAMPTON, Minister for Natural Resources, Environment and Heritage, under section 26(1)(a) of the *Heritage Conservation Act*, declare the remnant of WWII No. 6 Oil Tank Wall described in Schedule 1 to be a heritage place.

### SCHEDULE 1

All that parcel of land in the Town of Darwin, Northern Territory consisting of an area of 609 m<sup>2</sup> more or less:

- (a) being those parts of Lots 7577 and 8025 on Survey Plan S2011/151 bounded by a line commencing at the most eastern corner of Lot 7577 and bearing:
- 103° 10' for 7.5m; then
  - 220° 31' 20" for 1.35m; then
  - 283° 10' for 7.09 m; then
  - 303° 10' for 4.715 m; then
  - 312° 56' for 5.18 m; then
  - 331° 13' for 6.62 m; then
  - 349° 45' for 6.055 m; then
  - 9° 20' for 6.785 m; then
  - 24° 39' for 5.935 m; then
  - 115° 47' for 33.26 m; then
  - 220° for 21.145 m to the commencement point; and
- (b) as shown as Lot 8137(A) on the plan in Schedule 2.
