

PROPOSED EXCEPTIONAL DEVELOPMENT PERMIT

The land is within Zone SC (Service Commercial) of the NT Planning Scheme and use of the site for Multiple Dwellings would otherwise be prohibited.

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

Education Act ESTABLISHMENT OF GROUP SCHOOL MANAGEMENT COUNCILS

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
