SCHEDULE

AMENDMENT TO NT PLANNING SCHEME AMENDMENT No. 205

1. Citation

This amendment to the NT Planning Scheme may be cited as Amendment No. 205.

2. Definition

In this amendment -

"amending map" means the map, signed by the Minister for Lands and Planning and marked "NT Planning Scheme Amendment No. 205", deposited in the office of the Department of Lands and Planning, Darwin;

"zoning map" means the zoning map within the meaning of the NT Planning Scheme.

3. Amendment of Zoning Map

The NT Planning Scheme is amended by:

- (a) amending the zoning map relating to Darwin to the extent of its inconsistency with the amending map in respect of the area of land shown on the amending map bounded by a thick black line and lettered SD38 which is Lots 3564 and 3565 Town of Nightcliff (31 and 33 Moil Crescent, Moil); and
- (b) amending Schedule 1 to clause 2.4 Specific Uses to include the following table:

SD38 Lots 3564 and 3565 Town of Nightcliff (31 and 33 Moil Crescent, Moil)

- The purpose of this zone is to facilitate the use and development of the lots for single storey, multiple dwellings for seniors, aged pensioners and/or people with physical ailments or mobility impairments.
- With consent the land may be developed for the purpose of multiple dwellings if the development complies with all other requirements of the Planning Scheme as if the land were in Zone MD (Multiple Dwelling Residential).

If the development does not comply with the listed requirements, the consent authority may **consent** to a variation of the requirements only if it is satisfied that special circumstances justify the giving of **consent**.

- Despite paragraph 2, the consent authority must not consent to a development that exceeds:
- (a) one storey in height; and
- (b) any more than a total of four **multiple dwellings**.



DECLARATION OF PEST AND NOTIFIABLE PEST

I, STEPHEN JAMES WEST, Chief Inspector of Plant Health:

- (a) under section 6(2)(a) of the *Plant Health Act*, declare *Hylotrupes bajulus* (Linnaeus) (European house borer) to be a pest; and
- (b) under section 6(4) of the *Act*, specify that the declared pest mentioned in paragraph (a) is a notifiable pest.

Plant Health Act

RESTRICTION OF TRANSPORTATION INTO TERRITORY OF CERTAIN PLANT MATERIAL

I, STEPHEN JAMES WEST, Chief Inspector of Plant Health:

- (a) under section 17(2) of the *Plant Health Act* (as applied by section 77 of that *Act*) and section 43 of the *Interpretation Act*, revoke the notice, dated 20 August 2007 and published in *Gazette* G36 of 5 September 2007, prohibiting the importation of pinewood and pinewood articles into the Territory; and
- (b) under section 17(2) of the *Plant Health Act*, for the control of the declared pest *Hylotrupes bajulus* (Linnaeus) (European house borer), restrict the transportation into the Territory of specified host material of European house borer, as set out in the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

Restrictions applying to host material of European House Borer

- 1 The transportation into the Territory of pinewood timber from Western Australia is prohibited unless the timber is accompanied by a government certificate or assurance certificate that the timber has either undergone an approved treatment for the pest or has been sourced from a pest-free area.
- 2 The transportation into the Territory of pinewood pallets sourced from, or manufactured in, Western Australia is prohibited unless the pallets are:
 - (a) managed in accordance with a compliance arrangement, agreed to in writing between the Chief Inspector and either the person importing the pallets or the manufacturer of the pallets, with regard to management or manufacture of the pallets; or
 - (b) accompanied by a government certificate or assurance certificate that the pallets were sourced from a pest-free area.
- 3 The transportation into the Territory of pinewood firewood from Western Australia is prohibited except for commercial lots of pinewood firewood which are accompanied by a government certificate or assurance certificate that the firewood has undergone an approved treatment for the pest or has been sourced from a pest-free area.
- 4 In this instrument:

host material of European house borer means any raw, unprocessed and untreated coniferous timbers including pine, fir and spruce; and

- includes untreated pinewood building timber, untreated pinewood pallets and commercial lots of firewood; and
- (b) does not include untreated pinewood products such as dunnage and timber packing material, furniture, ornaments, artefacts, craft materials or household effects with pinewood components.

pinewood means wood from trees of the genera Abies, Araucaria, Picea, Pinus or Pseudotsuga.
