Fisheries Regulations FEES AND LEVIES

I, KONSTANTINE VATSKALIS, Minister for Primary Industry, Fisheries and Resources:

- (a) under regulations 206 and 207 of the Fisheries Regulations and with reference to section 43 of the *Interpretation Act*, revoke the notice prescribing fees and levies under the Fisheries Regulations dated 27 May 2011 and published in *Gazette* No. S27 on 31 May 2011; and
- (b) under regulation 206(1)(a) of the Fisheries Regulations and with reference to section 8 of the *Interpretation Act*:
 - prescribe the fee payable for the grant or renewal of a licence specified in Schedule 1 to be the amount specified opposite the licence; and
 - (ii) prescribe the fee payable for the grant of a Demersal Fishery licence applied for under regulation 224(1) of the Fisheries Regulations to be \$1 075.33; and
 - (iii) prescribe the fee payable for the grant of a Demersal Fishery licence applied for under regulation 224(2) of the Regulations to be \$8 472.25; and

- (iv) prescribe the fee payable for the grant of a Demersal Fishery licence under regulation 105 of the Regulations to be \$1 040; and
- (v) prescribe the fee payable for the renewal of a Demersal Fishery licence to be \$1 040; and
- (c) under regulation 206(1) of the Regulations, prescribe the fee payable for a matter mentioned in Schedule 2 to be the amount specified opposite the matter; and
- (d) under regulation 207(1) of the Regulations, prescribe a levy of \$800 to be paid by an applicant for the grant or renewal of a licence listed in Schedule 3 of the Regulations, other than for the grant of a Demersal Fishery licence applied for under regulation 224(1) or (2) of the Regulations.
