

NOTICE OF PROPOSED GRANT OF EXPLORATION PERMITS (PETROLEUM)

The Honourable Willem Westra Van Holthe MLA, the Northern Territory Minister for Mines and Energy, c/-Department of Mines and Energy, GPO Box 4550 DARWIN NT 0801, hereby gives notice in accordance with section 18 of the *Petroleum Act* (Northern Territory) and section 29 of the *Native Title Act* 1993 (Commonwealth) that application/s has/have been made for, and the Minister intends to grant, Exploration Permit/s (Petroleum) ("Permit") under Division 2 of Part II of the *Petroleum Act* (NT) as follows.

Exploration Permit 300 sought by TOM OATES, over an area of 53 Blocks depicted below for a term of 5 years, within the HALLS CREEK locality.



Nature of act(s): The grant of a permit under the *Petroleum Act*, gives the person to whom it is granted the exclusive right, for a term of up to 5 years, to explore for petroleum and to carry on such operations and execute such works as are necessary for that purpose in the area covered by the permit including (but not limited to) use of machinery and equipment for carrying out works, removal of material for testing, use of water resources for domestic use and to seek renewals. A permit may be renewed no more than twice. If petroleum is discovered in a Permit area, production licences and/or retention licences may subsequently be granted. Native Title Parties: Any person who is, or becomes a "native title party" within the meaning of the *Native Title Act* is entitled to the negotiation and/or procedural rights provided in Part 2, Division 3, Subdivision P of the *Native Title Act*. Under section 30 of the *Native Title Act*, persons have until 3 months after the notification day to take certain steps to become native title parties in relation to this notice. 

 Transport Act, determine that the maximum fares and charges that may be charged for the hire or use of a taxi are as set out in the Schedule.

Part 1 Maximum fares and charges for taxi areas other than Tennant Creek area

In this Part:

applicable area means each of the following taxi areas declared under section 16 of the *Act* as varied from time to time:

- (a) Darwin;
- (b) Alice Springs;
- (c) Katherine;
- (d) Gove.

core period means the period starting from 6 am and ending immediately before 6 pm

distance rate means the rate expressed in dollars per kilometre that may be charged for the distance travelled for a journey.

flagfall means the hire charge for a journey.

special journey means a journey for a wedding, funeral or other special occasion where the hiring includes waiting until the wedding, funeral or other special occasion has taken place and further carriage of the hirer immediately afterwards.

Tariff means Tariff 1, Tariff 2, Tariff 3, Tariff 4, Tariff 5 or Tariff 6.

Tariff 1, for an applicable area, means an amount specified in the table for that area for a journey:

- (a) made wholly within that area; and
- (b) starting on a weekday within the core period; and
- (c) for which a multiple hiring rate or high occupancy rate does not apply.

Tariff 2, for an applicable area, means an amount specified in the table for that area for a journey:

- (a) made partly within that area that starts at any time on any day, or made wholly within that area that starts:
 - (i) on a day other than a weekday; or
 - (ii) during a weekday outside the core period;
- (b) for which a multiple hiring rate or high occupancy rate does not apply.

Tariff 3, for an applicable area, means an amount specified in the table for that area for a journey:

- (a) made wholly within that area; and
- (b) starting on a weekday within the core period; and
- (c) for which a multiple hiring rate applies.

Tariff 4, for an applicable area, means an amount specified in the table for that area for a journey:

- (a) made partly within that area that starts at any time on any day, or made wholly within that area that starts:
 - (i) on a day other than a weekday; or
 - (ii) during a weekday outside the core period;and
- (b) for which a multiple hiring rate applies.

 $\it Tariff 5$, for an applicable area, means an amount specified in the table for that area for a journey: .

- (a) made wholly within that area; and
- (b) starting on a weekday within the core period; and

(c) for which a high occupancy rate applies.

Tariff 6, for an applicable area, means an amount specified in the table for that area for a journey:

- (a) made partly within that area that starts at any time on any day, or made wholly within that area that starts:
 - (i) on a day other than a weekday; or
 - (ii) during a weekday outside the core period;and
- (b) for which a high occupancy rate applies.

waiting time means the number of seconds of waiting time that must elapse before a charge of 10 cents may be made for a journey.

weekday means any day other than Saturday, Sunday or a public holiday.

- 2 A high occupancy rate applies only in relation to a journey for carriage of 5 or more passengers in a taxi licensed to carry 6 or more passengers.
- 3 A multiple hiring rate applies in relation to a journey only if:
 - (a) a high occupancy rate does not apply in relation to the journey; and
 - (b) the journey is undertaken for a passenger who has consented to multiple hiring of the taxi as defined in regulation 3(1) of the Taxis Regulations.
- 4 Subject to clauses 5 and 6, the maximum fare or charge that may be charged for the hire or use of a taxi for a journey made wholly or partly within an applicable area is the sum of:
 - (a) the amounts calculated in accordance with the applicable Tariff in the table for that area for the flagfall, the distance rate, and the waiting time, for so much of the journey as is made within that area; and
 - (b) any applicable airport exit toll.
- 5 If the journey is a special journey made wholly or partly within the Gove taxi area, the maximum fare or charge that may be charged for the hire or use of the taxi for so much of the journey as is made within the Gove taxi area is as follows:
 - (a) if the duration of the journey is one hour or less \$47.60:
 - (b) if the duration of the journey is more than one hour:
 - (i) for the first hour \$47.60; and
 - (ii) for each hour or part of an hour after the first hour \$23.30.
- 6 If a taxi is soiled by a passenger in the course of a journey, the maximum amount that may be charged for the cost of cleaning the taxi is \$50.
