Tobacco Control Act DECLARATION OF AREA NOT TO BE OUTDOOR EATING AND DRINKING AREA

AUSTRALIAN SUPERBIKES CHAMPIONSHIP 2012

I, KONSTANTINE VATSKALIS, Minister for Health, under section 5C of the *Tobacco Control Act*, declare the event area is not an outdoor eating and drinking area during all of the event, subject to the condition that the organiser of the event organiser:

- (a) prepare a smoking management plan (as defined in regulation 15B(6) of the Tobacco Control Regulations) that is satisfactory to the Chief Health Officer, as if the event organiser were a licensee and the area where the event is to be held were licensed premises; and
- (b) comply with the plan; and
- (c) make the plan available to members of the public at all times during the event.

In this instrument:

event means the Australian Superbikes Championship -Round 2, 2012 to be held at the Hidden Valley Race Track from 20 April 2012 to 22 April 2012.





PROPOSED EXCEPTIONAL DEVELOPMENT PERMIT LOT 2515 (8) ALRIDGE STREET, SUBURB OF ARALUEN, TOWN OF ALICE SPRINGS

Fisheries Act BARRAMUNDI FISHERY MANAGEMENT PLAN

ESTABLISH BUY-BACK SCHEME

I, KONSTANTINE VATSKALIS, Minister for Primary Industry, Fisheries and Resources, under clause 7 of the Barramundi Fishery Management Plan, establish the following barramundi licence buy-back scheme:

- (a) the scheme will commence on the date of publication of this instrument;
- (b) the Minister will call for expressions of interest and a licensee may participate in the scheme by lodging an expression of interest within the period specified by the Minister;
- (c) the Minister will determine the licences which will be bought back and the Minister is under no obligation to buy back any of the licences;
- (d) the licensee may surrender all units of gillnetting specified on the licence to the Territory in exchange for an amount to be agreed between the licensee and the Minister, taking into account the following:
 - (i) an evaluation of the licence by the Australian Valuation Office;
 - (ii) the market value of the licence;
 - (iii) the catch history of the licence;
 - (iv) any other relevant matter; and
- (e) the scheme is limited to the surrender of a number of units to be determined by the Minister and will terminate on the surrender of those units.
