FUNDS MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE

NOTICE

The Funds Management Committee gives notice, in accordance with section 392(4)(a) of the *Legal Profession Act 2006* of the making of a decision under section 392(1) of the *Legal Profession Act 2006*.

The decision is that in respect of the class of local legal practitioners who are not government lawyers and being the class prescribed by Regulation 84 of the Legal Profession Regulations as being required to pay an annual contribution under section 392(1) of the *Legal Practitioner Act 2006*:

- Local legal practitioners holding practising certificates in the category of "unrestricted" are required to pay a contribution of \$200.00 to the Legal Practitioners Fidelity Fund in respect of the period of 12 months commencing on 1 July 2012; and
- Local legal practitioners holding practising certificates in the categories of "Barrister", "restricted" (corporate) and "restricted (barrister and solicitor)" are required to pay no contribution to the Fidelity Fund in respect of the period of 12 months commencing on 1 July 2012.

In making this decision, the Funds Management Committee had regard to the advice of an Actuary as required by section 392(3) of the *Legal Profession Act 2006*.

Dangerous Goods Regulations

APPROVAL OF PERIODS FOR PURCHASING. POSSESSING AND FOR THROWING, IGNITING OR EXPLODING SHOPGOODS FIREWORKS

- I, DANIEL ROBERT KNIGHT, Minister for Justice and Attorney-General:
- (a) under regulation 139 of the Dangerous Goods Regulations, approve the period of time from 9 am to 9 pm on Sunday 1 July 2012 as a period during which a person may purchase shopgoods fireworks; and
- (b) under regulation 140(1) of the Regulations and with reference to regulation 140A(1) of the Regulations:
 - approve the period of time from 9 am on Sunday 1 July 2012 to 12 noon on Monday 2 July 2012 as a period during which a person may possess shopgoods fireworks, subject to the condition that this approval does not apply to the place specified in the Schedule; and
 - approve the period of time from 6 pm to 11 pm on Sunday 1 July 2012 as a period during which a person may throw, ignite or explode shopgoods fireworks, subject to the condition that this approval does not apply to the place specified in the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

All that parcel of land at Mindil Beach in the Town of Darwin, Northern Territory of Australia bounded by lines described as follows:
