**AMENDMENT OF WEED MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR BELLYACHE BUSH**

**(JATROPHA GOSSYPIIFOLIA)**

I, WILLEM RUDOLF WESTRA VAN HOLTJE, Minister for Land Resource Management, under section 12(5) of the *Weeds Management Act*, give notice of an amendment to the "Weed Management Plan for Bellyache Bush (*Jatropha gossypifolia*) 2010".

The amendment is necessary because the part of the Territory in which bellyache bush (*Jatropha gossypifolia*) is classified as a Class B weed is required to be expanded to include areas where it is not feasible to eradicate a number of infestations.

**Weeds Management Act**

**DECLARED WEED - BELLYACHE BUSH**

**(JATROPHA GOSSYPIIFOLIA)**

I, WILLEM RUDOLF WESTRA VAN HOLTJE, Minister for Land Resource Management:

- (a) under section 7(1) of the *Weeds Management Act* and with reference to section 43 of the *Interpretation Act*, revoke the instrument dated 22 January 2010 and published in *Gazette* No. G5 of 3 February 2010 entitled "Declared Weed - Bellyache Bush"; and
- (b) under section 7(1) of the *Weeds Management Act*:
  - (i) declare bellyache bush (*Jatropha gossypifolia*) (bellyache bush) to be a declared weed; and
  - (ii) classify bellyache bush as specified in Schedule 1, in the area described opposite each classification, and having regard to the provision of the *Act* specified opposite each classification.

**SCHEDULE 1**

Classification	Area	Provision of Act
Class A weed	The part of the Territory described in Schedule 2	7(4)(a) - necessary to eradicate bellyache bush
Class B weed	The part of the Territory described in Schedule 3	7(4)(b) - necessary to prevent the growing and spreading of bellyache bush
Class C weed	The whole of the Territory	7(4)(c) - necessary to prevent the introduction of bellyache bush

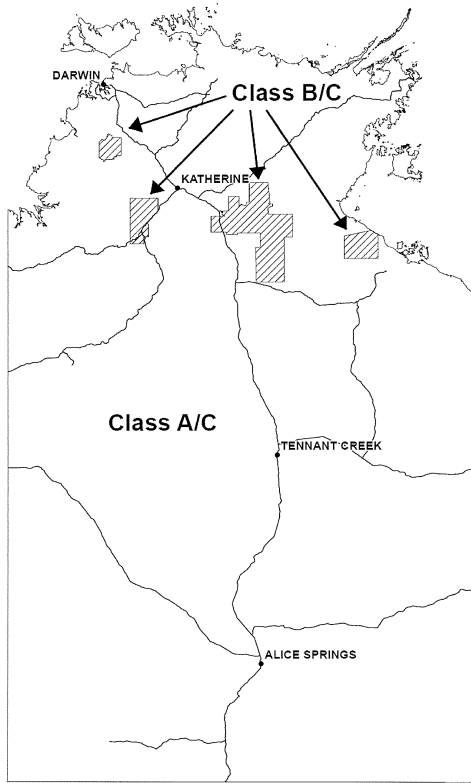
All of the Territory except the area described in Schedule 3.

**SCHEDULE 3**

**CLASS B AREA**

Inside that area of NTP 2682 (Tipperary Station); and inside that area starting at the most north west corner of NT Portion (NTP) 3982 (Aroona Station), moving southerly along the western boundary of NTP 3982, and of NTP 3983 (Willeroo Station), moving easterly along the southern boundary of NTP 3983, then the southern boundary of NTP 3867, then moving in a northerly direction along the eastern boundary of NTP 3983, then in an easterly direction along the southern boundary of NTP 3983, then moving northerly along the eastern boundary of NTP 3983, then moving in a north westerly direction along the north-eastern boundary of NTP 3983, then moving in a north easterly direction along the south eastern boundary of NTP 3982, then the south-eastern boundary of NTP 3981 (Scott Creek Station), then moving in a northerly direction along the eastern boundary of NTP 3981, then moving in a westerly direction along the northern boundary of NTP 3981, NTP 4175 and NTP 3982 closing at the north west corner of NTP 3982; and inside that area starting at the most north west corner of NTP 1288 (Moroak Station), then moving southerly along the western boundary of NTP 1288 until intersecting the northern boundary of the NTP 5417 (Mangarrayi Aboriginal Land Trust), then moving in a generally westerly direction along the northern boundary of NTP 5417 to the north eastern most corner of NTP 3069 (Elsey National Park) then along the northern, western and south western boundaries of NTP 3069 (Elsey National Park) until re-joining the northern boundary of NTP 5417, then moving in a westerly direction along the northern boundary of NTP 5417, then following the western and southern boundary of NTP 5417 until intersecting the western boundary of NTP 671 (Alawa Aboriginal Land Trust), then moving in a southerly direction along the western boundary of NTP 671, NTP 700 (Hodgson River Station) and NTP 1513 (Nutwood Downs Station) to the south western corner of NTP 1513, then moving in an easterly direction along the southern boundary of NTP 1513 to the south eastern corner of NTP 1513, then moving in a northerly direction along the eastern boundary of NTP 1513, NTP 700 and NTP 671, to the north eastern corner of the NTP 671, then moving in a westerly direction along the northern boundary of the NTP 671 to the south eastern corner of NTP 4777 (Kewulyi Aboriginal Land Trust), then moving in a northerly direction along the eastern boundary of NTP 4777 to the south eastern boundary of NTP 3276, then moving in a north easterly direction along the south eastern boundary of NTP 3276, and the south eastern boundary of NTP 4775 (Flying Fox Station) to the eastern boundary of NTP 4775, then moving in a northerly direction along the eastern boundary of NTP 4775 to the north eastern corner of NTP 4775, then moving in a westerly direction along the northern boundary of NTP 4775 and NTP 1288 closing at the most north west corner of NTP 1288 (Moroak Station); and inside that area of NTP 1333 (Lorella Station), as shown for information purposes only on the map in Schedule 4 and labelled Class B.

I, WILLEM RUDOLF WESTRA VAN HOLTHE, Minister for Land Resource Management, under section 12(5) of the *Weeds Management Act*, give notice of an amendment to the "Weed Management Plan for Mimosa (Mimosa pigra) 2010". The reason for the amendment is so that the management plan reflects:

- (a) the current locations of infestations of Mimosa (Mimosa pigra) (mimosa) in the Territory; and
- (b) the feasibility of control of mimosa in those locations.

**DECLARED WEED - MIMOSA (MIMOSA PIGRA)**

I, WILLEM RUDOLF WESTRA VAN HOLTHE, Minister for Land Resource Management:

- (a) under section 7(1) of the *Weeds Management Act* and with reference to section 43 of the *Interpretation Act*, revoke the instrument dated 2 March 2010 and published in *Gazette* No. G10 of 10 March 2010 entitled "Declared Weed Mimosa Pigra"; and
- (b) under section 7(1) of the *Weeds Management Act*:
  - (i) declare mimosa (Mimosa pigra) (mimosa) to be a declared weed; and
  - (ii) classify mimosa as set out in the Schedule.

Class A weed	The part of the Territory described in Part 2, shown for information purposes only on the map in Part 4 and labelled Class A	7(4)(a) - necessary to eradicate mimosa
Class B weed	The part of the Territory described in Part 3, shown for information purposes only on the map in Part 4 and labelled Class B	7(4)(b) - necessary to prevent the growing and spreading of mimosa
Class C weed	The whole of the Territory	7(4)(c) - necessary to the introduction of mimosa

**PART 2**

**CLASS A AREA**

All of the Territory except the area described in Part 3.

**PART 3**

**CLASS B AREA**

Inside that area starting at the Wildman River mouth, then moving in a southerly direction along the western boundary of Kakadu National Park until this meets the Mary River, moving across the Mary River in a westerly direction along the northern boundary of NT Portion 695, then moving in a southerly direction along the western boundary of NT Portion 695, then moving in a southerly direction until the boundary of NT Portion 5083, then moving in a north westerly direction along NT Portions 5786, 198, 209, 198 until this meets Coach Road, then following Coach Road until it meets the intersection of NT Portion 4036 and 795, then travelling in a westerly direction along the boundary of Litchfield National Park until it joins the north eastern extremity of NTP 3220,

then moving in a southerly direction until the south eastern extremity of NT Portion 6220, moving in a southerly direction until the Daly River Road, then moving in a south westerly direction across the Daly River, then moving in a west south west direction until the north eastern bank of Tom Turner Creek, then moving in a north west direction until the junction of the Moyle River, then moving in a west north west direction until the mouth of the Moyle River, then along a line following the coast in a generally north and east direction, closing at the Wildman River mouth; and inside that rectangular area contained within the 'Oenpelli floodplain' of parcel NTP 1646 that is described as starting at latitude (lat.) -12.1584 longitude (long.) 132.9200 (north west corner), moving easterly to lat. -12.1584, long. 133.0330 (north east corner), then moving southerly to lat. -12.2650, long. 133.0330 (south east corner), then moving westerly to lat. -12.2650, long. 132.9200 (south west corner), then moving northerly to re-join lat. -12.1584 long. 132.9200 (north west corner).
