

**Commercial Passenger (Road) Transport Act**DECLARATION OF TAXI AREAS
AND MINIBUS AREAS

I, ADAM GRAHAM GILES, Minister for Transport, with effect on and from 1 February 2013:

- (a) under section 16 of the *Commercial Passenger (Road) Transport Act* (the *Act*) and with reference to section 43 of the *Interpretation Act*, revoke the instrument entitled "Revocation of declaration of taxi areas and determination of number of taxi licences and declaration of taxi areas" dated 30 December 1998 and published in *Gazette* No. S49 on 31 December 1998; and
- (b) under section 16 of the *Act*, declare each area specified in the Schedule to be a taxi area for the purposes of the *Act*; and
- (c) under section 38 of the *Act* and with reference to section 43 of the *Interpretation Act*, revoke the instrument entitled "Revocation of declaration and declaration of minibus areas" dated 4 April 2003 and published in *Gazette* No. G16 on 23 April 2003; and
- (d) under section 38 of the *Act*, declare each area specified in the Schedule to be a minibus area for the purposes of the *Act*.

SCHEDULE

Name of area	Description of area
Darwin	All that area of land near Darwin bounded by lines described as commencing at the intersection of Goode Road and the Stuart Highway; then westerly along Jenkins Road to Bees Creek Road; then northerly along Bees Creek Road to the centreline of Elizabeth River; then generally north-westerly along the centreline of Elizabeth River to Low Water Mark at its tidal limit; then generally north-westerly by Low Water Mark of its right bank and by straight lines across the mouths of all intersecting creeks and rivers to the mouth of Sadgroves Creek; then generally southerly and northwesterly to Emery Point, generally north-easterly past East Point to Lee Point and generally south-easterly by the Low Water Marks of Port Darwin, Beagle Gulf and Shoal Bay to the centre of the mouth of Hope Inlet; then generally south-easterly and southerly by the centrelines of Hope Inlet and Howard River to the northern boundary of Section 4076 Hundred of Bagot; then easterly and southerly by the northern and eastern boundaries of Section 4076 and its prolongation southerly to the north-eastern corner of Section 247; then easterly to the north-eastern corner of Section 244; then southerly by eastern

boundaries of Sections 244, 265, 4449 and their prolongation southerly to Girraween Road; then easterly along Girraween Road to Coral Road; then southerly along Coral Road, Oscar Road and its southerly prolongation, Trippe Road North, across Arnhem Highway and again southerly along Trippe Road and its prolongation southerly to Goode Road at the south-eastern corner of Section 3043 Hundred of Strangways; then westerly along Goode Road to the point of commencement.

Alice Springs	The area within the municipal boundary of Alice Springs but excluding the land that is both south of Colonel Rose Drive and east of the Stuart Highway.
Katherine	The area within a 5 km radius of the Post Office at Katherine.
Tennant Creek	The area within a 5 km radius of the Post Office at Tennant Creek.
Gove	The area within a 16 km radius of the Post Office at Nhulunbuy.

 - (i) Darwin;
 - (ii) Alice Springs;
 - (iii) Katherine;
 - (iv) Tennant Creek;
 - (v) Gove.

SECURITY CAMERA SYSTEMS

I, ADAM GRAHAM GILES, Minister for Transport, with effect on and from 1 February 2013:

- (a) under regulation 18B of the Minibus Regulations (the Regulations) and with reference to section 43 of the *Interpretation Act*, revoke each declaration under regulation 18B of the Regulations in force immediately before the date of this instrument; and
- (b) under regulation 18B of the Regulations, declare that Part 3A of the Regulations applies in relation to each of the following minibus areas declared under section 38 of the *Commercial Passenger (Road) Transport Act*, as varied from time to time:
 - (i) Darwin;
 - (ii) Alice Springs;
 - (iii) Katherine;
 - (iv) Tennant Creek;
 - (v) Gove.

Traffic Regulations
EXEMPTION

I, PAUL NATHAN RAJAN, the Registrar of Motor Vehicles, under regulation 90(1) and 90(4) of the Traffic Regulations (the Regulations) and with reference to section 43 of the *Interpretation Act* revoke the instrument entitled

"Exemption" dated 7 January 2013 and published in *Gazette* No. G4 on 23 January 2013 and make the exemption as specified in the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

1. All drivers of commercial passenger vehicles (as defined in the *Commercial Passenger (Road) Transport Act*) are exempt from rules 265(3) and 226(1) of the Australian Road Rules for the purpose of driving passenger vehicles to carry passengers for hire or reward.
2. The exemption is subject to the following conditions:
 - (a) if there is an approved child restraint available in a vehicle it must be used in accordance with rules 266(2), 266(2A) and 266(2B) of the Australian Road Rules; and
 - (b) if a vehicle has 2 or more rows of seats a passenger who is under 4 years old must not travel in the front row of seats; and
 - (c) if a vehicle has 2 or more rows of seats a passenger who is 4 years old or older, but is less than 7 years old, must not travel in the front row of seats unless all of the other seats in the row or rows behind the front row are occupied by passengers who are also under 7 year old.
