REVOCATION OF NOTIFICATION AND  
NOTIFICATION

THE COLLEGE OF INVESTIGATIVE AND  
REMEDIAL CONSULTING ENGINEERS AUSTRALIA  
PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS SCHEME

I, JOHAN WESSEL ELFERINK, Attorney-General and  
Minister for Justice:

- (a) under section 13(1) of the *Professional Standards Act*, and with reference to section 43 of *The Interpretation Act*, revoke the instrument of notification dated 4 January 2013 and published in *Gazette* No. G4 of 23 January 2013; and
- (b) under section 13(1) of the *Professional Standards Act*, and with reference to section 14(1) of the *Act*, give notice that:
  - (i) a scheme entitled The College of Investigative and Remedial Consulting Engineers Australia Professional Standards Scheme has been approved by the Professional Standards Council constituted by the *Professional Standards Act 1994* (NSW) (**the Council**); and
  - (ii) the scheme commences 2 months after the day on which this notice is published in the *Gazette*, as specified in clause 6 of the scheme; and
