EXCEPTIONAL DEVELOPMENT PERMIT EDP12/0005

DESCRIPTION OF LAND THE SUBJECT OF THE PERMIT

#### Lot 06646 Town of Darwin 52 GREGORY ST. PARAP

#### APPROVED PURPOSE

To use and develop the land for the purpose of an al-fresco dining extension (including within the road reserve) to an existing restaurant, in accordance with the attached schedule of conditions and the endorsed plans.

#### BASE PERIOD OF THE PERMIT

This permit will lapse two years from the date of issue.

#### RIGHT OF APPEAL

There is no right of appeal against a determination by the Minister in relation to the grant or variation of an Exceptional Development Permit.

## SCHEDULE OF CONDITIONS CONDITION PRECEDENT

- Prior to the commencement of works (including site preparation), the applicant is to prepare a schematic plan demonstrating all stormwater can be collected on the site and discharged to Council's stormwater drainage system, to the requirements of the City of Darwin.
- Prior to the commencement of works (including site preparation), the applicant is to provide confirmation that a written agreement has been reached with the Power and Water Corporation with regard to the structures proposed to be located over the existing sewerage easement.

#### GENERAL CONDITIONS

- 3. Works carried out under this permit shall be in accordance with the drawings numbered 2010/001311 and 2010/0013/2, endorsed as forming part of this permit.
- Any developments on or adjacent to any easements on site shall be carried out to the requirements of the relevant service authority to the satisfaction of the consent authority.
- 5. The owner of the land must enter into agreements with the relevant authorities for the provision of water supply, drainage, sewerage facilities, and electricity services to the land shown on the endorsed plan in accordance with the authorities' requirements and relevant legislation at the time.
- Storage for waste disposal bins is to be provided to the requirements of the City of Darwin, to the satisfaction of the consent authority.

#### Notes:

 It is advised that, notwithstanding the approved plans, any proposed awnings, footpaths and landscaping works within Council's road reserve are subject to approval from the City of Darwin, and shall be undertaken at no cost to Council.

- 2. The City of Darwin advises that any signage for the site shall be wholly within the subject site and subject to Council Policy No. 42 - Outdoor Advertising Signs Code. In addition, any landscaping works within Council's road reserve are subject to Council's approval, shall meet Council's requirements to the satisfaction of the General Manager of Infrastructure, City of Darwin, and be at no cost to Council.
- 3. The Power and Water Corporation advises that the Water and Sewer Services Development Section (landdevelopmentnorth@powerwater.com.au) and Power Network Engineering Section (powerconnections@ powerwater.com.au) should be contacted via email a minimum of 1 month prior to construction works commencing in order to determine the servicing requirements of the Corporation and the need for upgrading of on-site and/or surrounding infrastructure.

### REASONS FOR THE DECISION

- 1. The development of an alfresco dining extension to an existing restaurant is considered appropriate for the site as it is integrated and compatible with the existing use of the premises, and is minor in its extent, restricting any potential detrimental impact on the surrounding locality, while providing an ancillary service to the existing restaurant. The alfresco extension is separated from the existing restaurant by a normally closed glazed door, which should ensure that any internally generated noise will not spill externally.
- The City of Darwin requires a stormwater drainage plan to confirm that it is technically feasible to collect stormwater on the site and dispose of it into its stormwater drainage system, and that stormwater will not sheet-flow into the road reserve or onto adjoining properties.
- The Power and Water Corporation requires an indemnity agreement with the developer/ applicant in the event that access is required to the sewerage easement, over which part of the development extends.


