DETERMINATION OF ADDITIONAL
LICENCE CONDITION

I, DAVID WILLIAM TOLLNER, Minister for Business, under section 33AA(2) of the *Liquor Act* and section 42 of the *Interpretation Act*, determine for each licence that allows the sale of liquor for consumption on or at licensed premises to which the licence relates (the licensed premises) that the additional licence condition specified in Part A of the Schedule shall be a condition of the licence for the licensed premises, subject to the qualifications specified in Part B of the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

Part A - Additional Licence Condition

A licensee or employee of a licensee shall exclude or remove from licensed premises any person who is wearing the colours, insignia or emblems of an outlaw motorcycle gang (Bikie Gang).

Part B - Qualifications to Additional Licence Condition

It is not a breach of this condition if the licensee has made reasonable attempts to remove persons wearing outlaw motorcycle gang colours, insignia or emblems from the licensed premises.

Reasonable attempts include, but are not limited to, calling the Police and seeking their advice and assistance.

The additional licence condition shall remain in force only from commencement of trade on 31 March 2013 until 04:00 Hours on 11 April 2013.
