



local legal practitioners holding practising certificates in the category of "barrister", only if they hold a trust account, are required to pay a contribution of \$250.00 to the Legal Practitioners Fidelity Fund.

Local legal practitioners holding practising certificates in the categories of "barrister", only if they do not hold a trust account, "restricted" (corporate) and "restricted (barrister and solicitor)" are required to pay no contribution to the Fidelity Fund.

In making this decision, the Funds Management Committee had regard to the advice of an Actuary as required by section 392(3) of the *Legal Profession Act*.


